January 26):- Yadadri Bhuvanagiri District Collector Hanumantha Rao stated that the government's objective is to provide government welfare schemes to all eligible beneficiaries, and as part of this, the district administration is working with utmost sincerity. On Monday, at the 77th Indian Republic Day celebrations held at the District Collectorate pre-



mises, District Collector Hanumantha Rao, along with the Additional Collector for Local Bodies and Revenue, Bhaskar Rao, paid tributes by garlanding the portraits of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar and Mahatma Gandhi, and then unfurled the national flag. Subsequently, the District Collector attended the Republic Day program organized at the Government Junior College in Bhuvanagiri town as the chief guest and received the guard of honor from the police along with DCP Akshansh Yadav. In this program, Government Whip and Alair MLA Beerla Ilaiah, Bhuvanagiri MLA Kumbham Anil Kumar Reddy, SP Akshansh Yadav, Library Chairman Aveez Chishti, Market Committee Chairman Rekha Baburao, DRO Jayamma, RDOs Krishna Reddy and Shekhar Reddy, officials and staff from all departments, and the public participated. Subsequently, battery-operated vehicles, laptops, and wheelchairs were distributed to eligible disabled persons in the district. The cultural programs presented by students from various schools captivated the audience. Greetings were extended to the people of Yadadri Bhuvanagiri district, public representatives, freedom fighters, and officials who attended the 77th Indian Republic Day celebrations. This is a festive occasion when the entire country celebrates Republic Day with joy and enthusiasm. Our hearts swell with pride as our national flag flutters. To uphold India as the greatest democratic country in the world, the Indian Constitution, drafted under the leadership of Bharat Ratna Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, came into effect on January 26, 1950. On this auspicious day, I pay my respects to the martyrs who fought for the country's independence and to the framers of the Constitution. “On this occasion, I am pleased to explain to you the progress

of various development schemes and welfare programs being implemented in the district. Mahalakshmi Scheme: “In our district, so far, free travel has been provided to 1 crore 97 lakh women passengers on RTC buses, amounting to Rs. 102 crore 79 lakh. “With the objective of empowering women and providing cooking gas cylinders at a lower price through the Mahalakshmi scheme, the government decided to provide LPG subsidized cylinders for Rs. 500. As part of this, in our district, 1,27,981 beneficiaries have been identified under the Mahalakshmi scheme, and 5,56,172 cylinders have been distributed, with a subsidy amount of Rs. 17 crore credited to their accounts. “Gruha Jyothi Scheme: “Under the Gruha Jyothi scheme, electricity worth Rs. 96 crore 96 lakh has been provided to 1,50,568 consumers with zero bills since March 2024. “Agriculture Department: “Rythu Bharosa: “Under the Rythu Bharosa scheme, we are providing financial assistance of Rs. 12,000 per acre. In this financial year, Rs. 306 crore 46 lakh has been credited to the accounts of 2,33,418 farmers. “Farm Loan Waiver: “Considering the welfare of farmers as its primary duty, the state government, under the Crop Loan Waiver 2024, has waived loans amounting to Rs. 628 crore 72 lakh for 77,660 farmers who had taken crop loans in our district. Farmers' Insurance Scheme: “Under the Farmers' Insurance Scheme, in our district, an amount of Rs. 9 crore 30 lakh has been deposited into the accounts of the nominees of 186 farmers who passed away during the year 2025-26. “Under the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi scheme, a total of Rs. 462 crore 64 lakh has been deposited into the accounts of eligible farmers in the district in 21 installments so far by the Central Government as investment assistance. “Horticulture Department: “In our district, horticultural and mulberry crops are being cultivated on 25,203 acres. In the last three years, oil palm cultivation has been undertaken on 4,500 acres in our district. From the 165 acres where the crop was ready for harvest, 56 metric tons of bunches were harvested and sent to the mills. Against the target of cultivating new plantations on 3,500 acres this year, planting has been completed on 570 acres so far. “Indiramma Houses: “In the 5 constituencies of the district, Indiramma houses have been sanctioned to 9,735 beneficiaries, and all of them are nearing completion. So far, Rs. 195 crore 10 lakh has been deposited into the bank accounts of the beneficiaries, depending on the construction stage of their houses. The state government has commended us in this regard. He said that

crores of rupees have been spent on irrigation and command area development. The main objective of Package-15 in the district is to provide irrigation water to 63,300 acres. So far, 79.88% of the works under Package-15 have been completed at a cost of Rs. 617 crores. The final works of the main canal lining are in progress. “Package-16 involves works on the main canal from 36.169 km to 94 km, a total length of 55.51 km, for which a contract has been awarded for Rs. 1059 crores and 75 lakhs. Through this package, it is proposed to provide irrigation water to 1,65,500 acres in M.Turkapally, Yadagirigutta, Bhuvanagiri, Gundala, Alair, Atmakur, Valigonda, Choutuppal and Narayanapur mandals of our district through the respective distributary channels. So far, 60% of the works under this package have been completed at a cost of Rs. 671 crores. Gandamalla Reservoir: “Honorable Chief Minister Sri A. Revanth Reddy has laid the foundation stone for the construction of the Gandamalla reservoir, a long-cherished dream of the people of the district. The construction of this reservoir, with a water capacity of 1.41 TMC, has been contracted for Rs. 358 crores and 16 lakhs. Land acquisition works for this reservoir are in progress. This project will enable the irrigation of 56,000 acres of land and the filling of 50 tanks in the Aleru constituency. So far, funds amounting to Rs. 27.53 crores have been sanctioned for compensation payments. “Bhuniyadigani, Pillayapalli and Dharmareddy Canals: A contract worth Rs. 195 crores has been awarded for the completion of the Bhuniyadigani canal construction. This canal will bring 14,575 acres of new ayacut (irrigated area) under cultivation and stabilize 6,000 acres of ayacut under existing tanks. Land acquisition is in various stages. A contract worth Rs. 58.30 crores has been awarded for the completion of the Pillayapalli canal construction. The works on these canals are in progress. This canal will bring 16,525 acres of new ayacut under cultivation and stabilize approximately 6,000 acres of ayacut under 84 tanks. A contract worth Rs. 84 crores has been awarded for the completion of the Dharmareddy canal construction. The works on these canals are in progress. This canal will bring 12,661 acres of new ayacut under cultivation and stabilize 5,126 acres of ayacut. “District Rural Development Agency: “Under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme, 16.17 lakh man-days of work have been created, and Rs. 71.04 crores have been spent. Cheyutha Scheme: “In our district, a total of 97,666 beneficiaries, including the elderly, widows, dis-

abled persons, toddy tappers, weavers, single women, and beedi workers, are being distributed a monthly pension of Rs. 24.70 crores. Self-Help Groups: “In this financial year, under the program of distributing loans to women's groups through banks, a target of Rs. 611.17 crores was set, and so far, loan facilities worth Rs. 597.44 crores have been provided. “As part of the Women's Em-



powerment program, Rs. 13.38 crores have been sanctioned to 475 self-help groups through the Stree Nidhi scheme. “Urban Poverty Alleviation Organization (MEPMA): “In the district's (6) municipalities, through bank linkage, Rs. 114 crores have been sanctioned to 845 self-help groups so far this year, and Rs. 24.05 crores have been sanctioned to 385 self-help groups through the Stree Nidhi scheme. Interest-free loans for women's groups: In this financial year, under the program of distributing loans to women's groups through banks, interest-free loan checks worth Rs. 7.75 crores have been distributed in our district so far. “Indira Mahila Shakti Saree Distribution: Under the Indira Mahila Shakti Saree Distribution scheme, sarees are being distributed to all women aged 18 years and above who possess a ration card. As part of this, 2,03,394 sarees will be distributed in our district. Civil Supplies Department: Fine rice for the poor: In the district, 4,961 metric tons of fine rice are being distributed every month to 2,48,757 eligible families through 515 ration shops. “Issuance of new ration cards: “While the process of issuing new ration cards is underway in the district, from January 2025 to date, 34,039 new cards have been issued, and 1,80,094 units have been added, and ration distribution is being carried out. On this occasion, Yadadri Bhuvanagiri District Collector Hanumantha Rao expressed his gratitude to the public representatives, officials, non-officials, journalists, bankers, and police officers who are cooperating in bringing the administration closer to the people and ensuring that the fruits of development reach everyone in Yadadri Bhuvanagiri district. He urged everyone to work together to lead Yadadri Bhuvanagiri district on the path of development.
