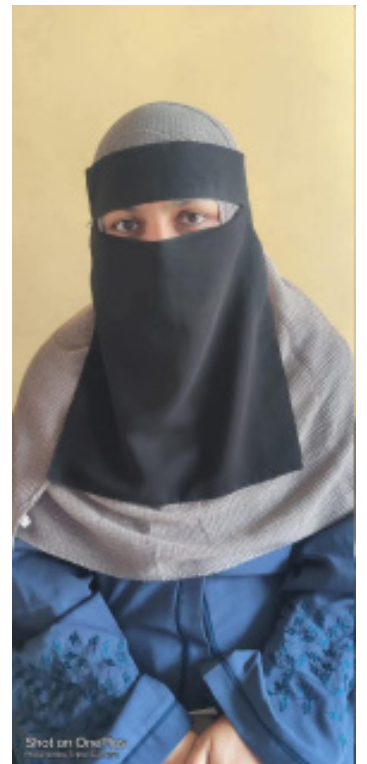

February 17):- District Collector Hanumantha Rao has instructed the relevant officials to make strong arrangements to organize the annual Brahmotsavams of Yadagirigutta Sri Lakshminarasimha Swamy from 18th to 28th of this month in a grand manner. On Tuesday, the Collector held a coordination meeting with the relevant officials in his chamber along with the Additional Collector of Local Bodies Bhaskar Rao. Speaking on the occasion, the District Collector said... The work assigned to the relevant officials to organize the annual Brahmotsavams of the Swamy from February 18th to 28th should be completed quickly. Special arrangements should be made keeping in mind the VIPs. He instructed the officials to make arrangements keeping in mind that more devotees will come to the temple from different places every day. He instructed to make special arrangements especially for the Swami Vaarai Komagal Mahotsavam on the 24th of this month, the Swami Vaarai Kalyana Mahotsavam on the 25th, and the Swami Vaarai Divya Vimana Rathotsavam on the 26th. He said that while monitoring the security arrangements and the facilities required by the devotees, all the arrangements should be made as per the protocol without any room for mistakes, the temple surroundings should be kept clean and the queue lines should be managed properly. The municipal officials should make arrangements to ensure that the temple surroundings are clean, sanitation, drinking water facilities, and toilets are clean. He said that the police should be set up and constantly monitored. He advised the police department to make adequate arrangements, traffic management, security, and parking arrangements to prevent any untoward

incidents. He instructed the R&B officials to immediately repair the small potholes on the Ghat roads leading to the hill and the footpaths used by Kali. On Tuesday, a meeting was held with MPDOs, MPOs and housing staff at the mini meeting hall to review the construction work of Indiramma Houses beneficiaries who have completed the construction work. District Collector Hanumantha Rao reviewed the work of job cards, employment guarantee scheme and construction of toilets for the beneficiaries who have completed the Indiramma Houses, mandal-wise. “ Speaking on this occasion, the Collector said that job cards should be given to the beneficiaries of Indiramma houses in every mandal in the district. He asked the concerned officials how much payment was given for 90 days of work under the Employment Guarantee Scheme. from Hyderabad with the election officers-collectors, EROs, AEROs of all districts through video conference on the mapping process undertaken before the special comprehensive amendment. Speaking on the occasion, the State Chief Electoral Officer said that steps should be taken to complete the mapping process by providing assistance to the booth level officers. Booth level officers should return to complete the mapping process from house to house, and for this, village administration officers and other officers should be appointed as assistants to the booth level officers in mapping and steps should be taken to complete the mapping process quickly. He said that awareness should be created by talking to the representatives of recognized political parties and appointing booth level agents from their party. Booth level officers should travel to the field level and undertake the mapping process, and the supervisors of booth level officers and AEROs should provide assistance and cooperation to them in mapping and ensure that the process is carried out in a systematic manner without any mistakes. Rabi 2025-26 and ensure that the farmers do not face any difficulties. “On Tuesday, the Additional Collector held a review meeting with the concerned authorities representing the paddy procurement in his chamber. Speaking on the occasion, the Additional Collector “said...that farmers should not face any difficulties at the procurement centers and that the procurement of paddy should be done through the token method and that the procurement should be done smoothly. He suggested that the purchase centers should be set up after checking the height and valleys. It was suggested that proper infrastructure, i.e. weighing machines, automatic paddy cleaners, tarpaulins, and gunny bags should be prepared in the purchase centers. It was suggested that at least 50 tarpaulin sheets should be provided to each purchase center. Similarly, in view of the summer, basic facilities like drinking water, shade, sheds, tents, chairs, etc. should be provided to the farmers, managers, and staff without any difficulty. If there is any problem, it was suggested that it should be brought to their attention immediately. It was further suggested that all PPC centers should register the relevant entries in the PCSAP portal by the end of this month. District Rural Development Officer Nagi Reddy, District Civil Supplies Officer Roja Rani, Civil Supplies Corporation District Manager Hari Krishna, District Agriculture Officer Ramana Reddy, concerned officers and staff participated in this meeting.

Speaking on this occasion, the Collector mentioned about the works sanctioned in the district and inquired about the stage at which they are currently at, to what extent funds have been spent, where facilities have been renovated and other details. The construction work of the Shri Shakti Bhavan under construction in the Collectorate should be completed quickly.
