

## Stay Away from Drugs: Be Vigilant About Road Safety and Cyber Frauds.

ASHOKAN “KARIMNAGAR BUREAU “ As part of the Prajapalana-Pragati Pranalika initiative, the Manthani Police organized an awareness program focusing on child safety, the dangers of drug abuse, cyber crimes, and road accident prevention. The program was held on Saturday at the Narasimha Shiva Kiran Garden in Manthani under the supervision of the Manthani Police Department. “The event was graced by several distinguished guests, including Peddapalli DCP B. Ram Reddy, Godavarikhani ACP Ramesh, spiritual speaker Nayak Maharaj, Manthani Municipal Chairman Vodnala Srinivas, Vice Chairman Muskula Sahender Reddy, Agricultural Market Committee Chairman Kududala Venkanna, and Manthani Municipal Commissioner Manohar Reddy. “At the outset, Manthani SI Ramesh welcomed the chief guests by presenting them with bouquets. “Addressing the gathering, the speakers emphasized that addiction to narcotic substances can completely ruin an individual’s future. They advised students to set clear goals from an early stage of their academic life and work diligently to achieve them. They highlighted that the future of the nation lies in the hands of the youth, urging students to pursue education with dedication and bring pride to their parents and their region. “The dignitaries further stated that the natural enthusiasm and energy of young people should be channelled into education, sports, and social development. They cautioned that this phase of life is characterized by strong physical and mental energy, and if that energy is diverted towards

substance abuse, it will first damage health and eventually endanger one’s entire life. “They urged the public to completely avoid the use of narcotic substances. If anyone is found to be addicted, people should initially try to counsel and reform them; however, if no change occurs, the matter should be reported to the police. The police department reiterated that strict action will be taken against the illegal trafficking and consumption of narcotics. “The speakers also highlighted that road accidents predominantly involve young people. According to reports, nearly 60 to 70 percent of road accident victims are youth. They advised motorists to wear helmets while riding two-wheelers and use seat belts while driving cars. They also instructed drivers to always travel on the left side of the road and exercise caution while overtaking heavy vehicles. Driving under the influence of alcohol was identified as one of the primary causes of fatal road accidents. “With regard to cyber crimes, students were cautioned to remain highly vigilant. They were advised not to share One-Time Passwords (OTPs), respond to suspicious phone calls, or click on unknown links sent through messages. “The speakers explained that in earlier times parents used to warn children not to accept chocolates from strangers, whereas today similar frauds occur through deceptive mobile links and messages. While mobile phones have made it easier to connect with the world, they also provide opportunities for cyber criminals to exploit unsuspecting individuals. “The program witnessed the participation of Manthani municipal council members, village sarpanches, former sarpanches, police personnel, and nearly 300 students, making the awareness campaign both informative and impactful.

# Release farmer support funds

## Full-scale loan waiver demanded OC leaders Kishan Reddy and Rajanna appeal to farmers on hunger strike

““Jagityal Correspondent , March 14 (Indian Chronicle) : “OC JAC state vice-presidents Ennam Kishan Reddy and Jagityal district convenor Mahankali Rajanna have urged the state government to immediately release two installments of farmer support funds into the accounts of farmers. ## Special Intensive Revision (SIR) Process Must Be Completed Expeditiously: State Chief Electoral Officer Sudarshan Reddy

March 14): State Chief Electoral Officer Sudarshan Reddy has directed that the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) process, undertaken for the amendment of voter lists, be completed with utmost speed. “On Friday, speaking from Hyderabad via video conference, State Chief Electoral Officer Sudarshan Reddy



reviewed the progress of the Special Intensive Revision process with all District Collectors and Election Officers. “Speaking on this occasion, the State Chief Electoral Officer emphasized that the mapping process—a key component of the special revision of voter lists—must be conducted comprehensively to ensure there is absolutely no scope for errors. He directed Supervisors and AEROs to constantly tour the field level to oversee and complete the mapping process. He further instructed that the voter lists be scrutinized meticulously to prevent any instances of a single individual having their name registered as a voter in two different locations. He also directed that Booth Level Agents be appointed through political parties and stressed that it is mandatory for all Booth Level Officers to possess valid ID cards. 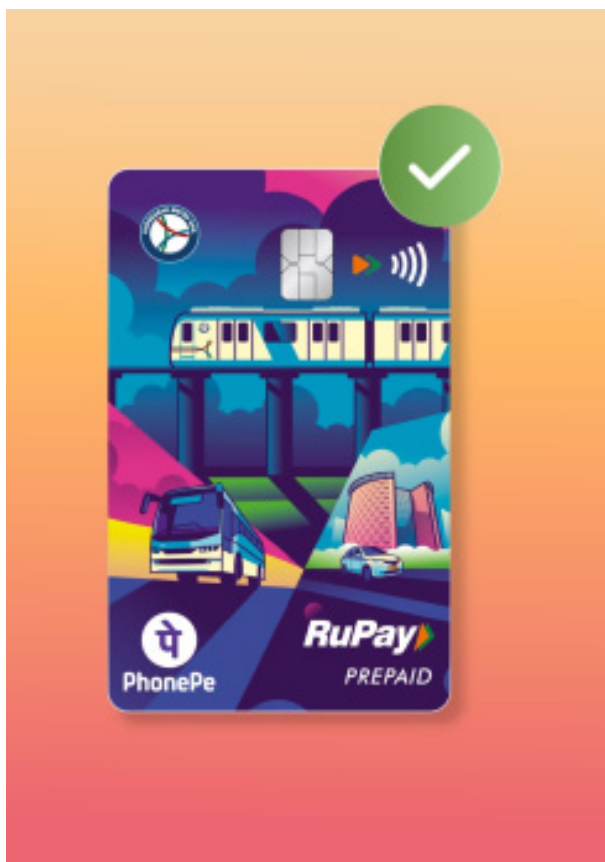
