Suraj Kumar Death Case: Gogikar Shivakumar's Efforts Yield Results



“NARRA SRINIVAS REDDY (NSR), Medchal - Malkajgiri Staff Reporter, March 26, (Indian chronicle):“Justice has finally been delivered to the family of 14-year-old Suraj Kumar, a Class 9 student who died due to the alleged negligence of the Gopi School management in Vasavi Nagar Colony. The incident gained public attention after strong coverage by both print and electronic media. The issue was widely reported, highlighting the family's suffering and creating pressure on authorities to take action. Gogikar Shivakumar played a key role in pursuing the case. He stated that media support helped bring the issue into the public domain and increased awareness, which in turn forced the administration to respond. Following a protest held under his leadership in front of the school, the management was compelled to act. Police registered a case against the school authorities. In addition to legal action, financial assistance of ₹3 lakh was arranged for the victim's family to support them during this difficult time. Shivakumar said that injustice against children will not be tolerated and added that the combined efforts of the media and the public made it possible to secure justice in this case. He also assured continued support for victims in the future.

Call for “Chalo Hyderabad” on March 28: ASHA Workers Demand Rs18,000 Fixed Salary



“NARRA SRINIVAS REDDY (NSR), Medchal - Malkajgiri Staff Reporter, March 26, (Indian chronicle):“Hyderabad: The Telangana ASHA Workers Union has called for a massive “Chalo Hyderabad” protest on March 28, urging the state government to address long-pending demands of ASHA workers. Union State Secretary M. Revathi Kalyani said that around 28,000 ASHA workers in Telangana have been providing essential healthcare services to poor and vulnerable communities for nearly two decades. Despite their critical role, they continue to work without basic legal protections and assured wages. The union has demanded that the state government fix a minimum monthly salary of ₹18,000 for ASHA workers in the ongoing Assembly budget sessions. They also called for adequate allocation of funds to the National Health Mission (NHM) to resolve pending issues and ensure timely payment of honorariums every month. ASHA workers allege that promises made by the Congress party in its election manifesto, including wage hikes and job security, remain unfulfilled even after two years in power. Several assurances such as ₹50 lakh insurance coverage, ₹50,000 for funeral expenses, and retirement benefits have not been implemented so far. In addition, payments related to PRC arrears, leprosy, pulse polio duties, and election duties have reportedly been pending for years. Irregular payment of monthly honorariums has further pushed workers into financial distress. Union Working President K. Unnikrishnan criticized successive governments for failing to recognize ASHA workers as formal workers and for not extending benefits such as ESI, PF, gratuity, and accident insurance. He stated that making promises during elections without implementation reflects poorly on governance. The union warned that if the government fails to act immediately and implement the promised ₹18,000 fixed salary, ASHA workers will be forced to go on strike and launch an indefinite agitation. The union has appealed to all ASHA workers to participate in large numbers and make the March 28 “Chalo Hyderabad” program a success.

Suspicious Death of Woman in Dammaiguda; Harassment Angle Suspected



“NARRA SRINIVAS REDDY (NSR), Medchal - Malkajgiri Staff Reporter, March 26, (Indian chronicle):“Jawarnagar: A 35-year-old woman was found dead under suspicious circumstances in Dammaiguda on Wednesday, raising allegations of harassment and possible murder. According to the complaint lodged by Dasari Yellaiah (28), a daily wage worker residing in Devender Nagar, Jawaharnagar under Kapra Mandal of Medchal–Malkajgiri district, the deceased has been identified as his sister, Dyaverangula Vijaya. She was originally from Chennakesava Colony near Mangalpally Gate in Amangal Mandal of Mahabubnagar district. Vijaya, a daily labourer, is survived by her two sons, Shiva (14) and Charan (12). She used to go regularly to the Dammaiguda labour adda for work. On March 25, at around 3:00 PM, Vijaya left her house informing her children that she would collect money from a mason contractor and return home by 8:00 PM. However, she did not return that night. Family members initially did not alert the police, as she had occasionally returned late in the past. On the morning of March 26, around 10:00 AM, a relative of the complainant received a phone call stating that a woman’s body was found lying in bushes behind Manisha Wines in Dammaiguda. The caller also shared a photograph. Upon reaching the spot, the family members identified the body as that of Vijaya. The complainant alleged that Yashoda, a relative residing in Ambedkar Nagar, Jawaharnagar, and one Balaswamy of Shanti Nagar, Jawaharnagar, frequently harassed Vijaya, assaulted her, and took money from her. He further stated that Balaswamy had been troubling her continuously in recent days. Observing injuries on her face and signs of bleeding, the complainant suspects that Vijaya may have been murdered, possibly by Balaswamy. Police have registered a case and initiated an investigation into the incident.

Telangana Activists Should Not Be Misled: Student JAC Chairman Ponugoti Sampath

“Avnreddy Khammam Staff Reporter March 26,(Indian Chronicle):“Ponugoti Sampath, Chairman of the Telangana Student Joint Action Committee (JAC) and State Spokesperson of the Telangana Activists Welfare Association, has urged Telangana activists not to fall prey to fake organizations that are emerging in the name of activists’ JACs.“He stated that during both phases of the Telangana movement, many individuals played a crucial role and fought tirelessly to achieve the long-cherished dream of a separate state. However, in recent times, several fraudulent groups have surfaced, making false promises in the name of activists’ welfare.“Sampath warned that some of these organizations claim they will fight until the promises made in the Congress party’s election manifesto are implemented. He questioned where these leaders were during the actual movement and which parties they belonged to, urging genuine activists to verify their background.“He alleged that individuals who did not actively participate in the movement are now organizing fake meetings under the banner of activists’ JACs. These groups are misleading people by promising benefits such as 250-square-yard house plots, housing construction, financial support for martyrs’ families, jobs for family members, pensions, and identity cards recognizing them as freedom fighters.According to Sampath, some unregistered organizations are exploiting innocent activists financially by collecting money in the name of memberships, ID cards, housing plots, and pension schemes. He also accused them of spreading misinformation against the Congress government for their own financial gain.He emphasized that while the government is taking steps to fulfill the promises made in its election manifesto, these fake organizations are trying to provoke activists against the government, thereby creating a gap between genuine activists and the administration.“Sampath mentioned that the government is planning to establish a Welfare Board for activists under the leadership of Kodandaram. Intelligence agencies, including State Intelligence, Special Branch, and CID, are already collecting details of individuals who actively participated in the movement.“He clarified that having police cases is not the sole criterion to identify an activist, as many individuals actively participated in JAC programs without facing arrests or cases. The government, he said, will categorize activists under various criteria.“He further urged that those forming organizations in the name of activists should disclose their movement history, including arrests, cases, and contributions, before conducting meetings. Otherwise, he warned that legal action would be taken in coordination with genuine activists.“He concluded by appealing to people not to be misled and to remain cautious of fraudulent groups exploiting the name of the Telangana movement.



“Save Agriculture, Protect the Nation”: AIKMS Calls for Nationwide Mobilisation

“Arvapalli Nagesh Khammam Bureau March 26,(Indian Chronicle):“The Central Executive Committee (CEC) of the All India Kisan Mazdoor Sabha held a two-day meeting on March 25–26 in Khammam, calling upon people to prepare for an agricultural movement under the slogan “Save Agriculture, Protect the Nation.” At a press conference, AIKMS National President Vemulapalli Venkatramayya, National General Secretary Ashish Mittal, and National Leader Rabinder Singh Patiala addressed the media. They also urged people to make the upcoming AIKMS National Conference in Khammam this September a success. “Concerns Over Government Policies” “The meeting discussed in detail what it described as increasing attacks by the central government on farmers, allegedly aimed at benefiting corporate interests, including foreign companies, by weakening farmers and turning agriculture into a resource base for profit. “Opposition to New Employment Scheme” “The CEC strongly opposed the proposed VB Ramji employment law, which is set to replace the existing rural employment guarantee scheme. “Unlike the demand-driven model where Gram Sabhas determine work, the new scheme is described as supply-driven. “It reportedly prioritizes corporate-linked rural works like water projects and cold storage construction. “Wage levels remain below market rates. “The scheme promises 125 days of work, but responsibility lies with state governments. “Central funding is reduced from 90% to 60%. “Electricity Bill 2025 Criticised” “AIKMS demanded withdrawal of the Electricity Bill 2025, citing: “Removal of cross-subsidies” “Imposition of commercial rates on poor consumers” “Introduction of smart prepaid meters” “The organisation demanded: “300 units of free electricity for all” “Free power for agriculture” “Recovery of losses from wealthy sections instead of burdening the poor” “Opposition to Seed Bill 2025” “The committee also opposed the proposed Seed Bill 2025, stating that it: “Allows untested foreign and genetically modified seeds” “Removes restrictions on black marketing” “Weakens India’s seed sovereignty” “They noted that six major global corporations control 90% of the world seed market, calling the policy “dangerous.” “Trade Agreements and Agriculture” “AIKMS criticised the Indian government’s trade understanding with the United States, alleging it benefits American interests at the cost of Indian farmers. “Concerns include: “Reduction of import duties to near zero” “Increased export duties” “Impact on crops like soybean, maize, cotton, poultry, dairy, and fruits” “Farmers’ Demands” “The organisation reiterated key demands: “Legal guarantee for Minimum Support Price (MSP)” “Farm loan waivers” “Implementation of the M. S. Swaminathan Commission



recommendations “They also criticised large-scale corporate loan waivers while farmers continue to face rising costs. “Land Issues and Evictions” “The meeting condemned demolition of houses built on Bhoodan land in Khammam, calling it illegal and citing High Court interim orders. It demanded distribution of such lands to eligible poor families for housing or farming. “Call for Unity and Protest” “AIKMS resolved to strengthen nationwide struggles in coordination with the Samyukt Kisan Morcha against anti-farmer policies. “It also called for: “Proper implementation of the Forest Rights Act (FRA 2006) and PESA” “Protection of tribal and forest dwellers’ rights” “Resistance against corporate land acquisition” “International Issues. The organisation condemned ongoing global conflicts, particularly actions involving the United States and Israel, warning that wars are destabilising economies and increasing prices worldwide, including in India’s agricultural sector. “Upcoming National Conference” “AIKMS announced that its 4th All India Conference will be held in Khammam on September 28–30, 2026, and preparations have begun.

Call to Make March 30 Assembly Siege a Success, Beyond Political Affiliations

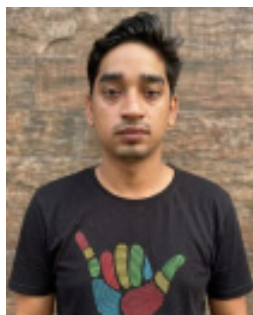

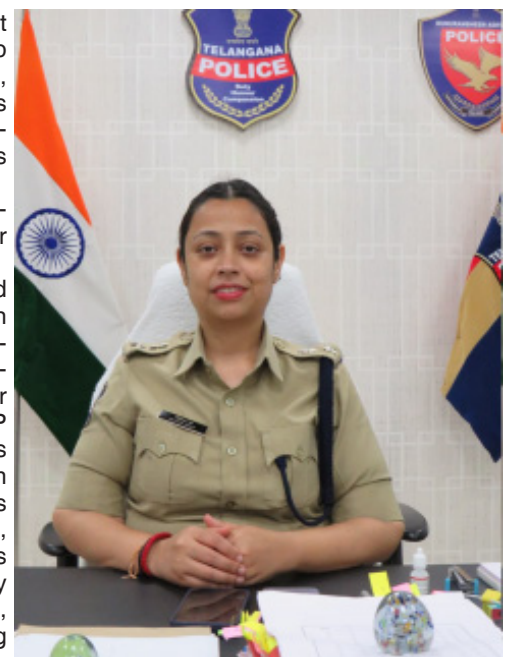
Auto-Rickshaw Overturns... Student Dies.

...“Devulapally Srinivas, Warangal Bureau / Geesugonda, March 26 (Indian Chronicle): An incident involving the death of a 10th-grade student in a road accident occurred in Gorrekunta. According to details provided by locals, Ladella Praveen and Sunitha—residents of Gorrekunta Municipal village, located in Division 15 of the Warangal Municipal Corporation—have two children: Mintu and Akshay. On the morning of Wednesday, the 25th of this month, while Akshay was traveling in an auto-rickshaw to fetch drinking water, the vehicle lost control near the village and overturned. Akshay sustained severe injuries in the accident; locals responded immediately and rushed him to the MGM Hospital in Warangal. Doctors stated that Akshay passed away on Thursday morning while undergoing treatment at the hospital. The deceased was a 10th-grade student at the Government School in Gorrekunta. “The incident has cast a pall of gloom over the village. Meanwhile, Geesugonda CI Vishweshwar disclosed the details surrounding the case. He explained that the deceased and Praveen (the auto-rickshaw owner's son)—who was also injured—were traveling together to fetch water when the vehicle accidentally overturned, causing them both injuries. He further stated that the deceased sustained a severe head injury and, despite being shifted to MGM Hospital for treatment, succumbed to his injuries on Thursday. Geesugonda CI Vishweshwar confirmed that a case has been registered, and an investigation is underway.
