Karimnagar police bust Rs 138-crore cyber fraud racket; 13 held, Mule account network dismantled; probe reveals organised financial crime.

Khaja Sikander Mohiuddin Staff Reporter, Indian Chronicle Karimnagar, March 27: The Karimnagar Police has unearthed a large cyber fraud network involving the use of 'mule' bank accounts, arresting 13 persons and identifying 24 accused in what officials described as a major breakthrough under "Operation Crackdown 1.0".

According to the police, the network facilitated illegal financial transactions to the tune of nearly ₹138 crore through a web of virtual accounts and bank accounts, primarily linked to Ratnakar Bank Limited (RBL) and certain cooperative societies.

Eight cases (Crime Nos. 68, 69, 71, 73, 74, 75, 76, and 77 of 2026) have been registered under Sections 112 and 318(4) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) and Section 66-D of the Information Technology Act. While seven cases pertain to RBL Bank, one relates to a virtual platform identified as "Rapid Grow Virtual".

Police investigations revealed a well-organised modus operandi. Coordinators managed the creation and operation of mule accounts, while middlemen lured unsuspecting individuals with monetary incentives to open bank accounts. These account holders then handed over their credentials, enabling cybercriminals to route fraudulent proceeds, often to overseas destinations.

The arrested accused have been identified as Bandari Sairam (30) of Velgatoor in Jagtial district, Anumandla Ranjith (36) of Gopulapur in Buggaram mandal, Aligeti Malleesh (37) of Dharmaram in Peddapalli district, Boga Rakesh (35) of Jagtial, and Bandi Pranay (25) of Vedire in Ramadugu mandal of Karimnagar district.

Also among those arrested are bank officials Bhuvanagiri Kalyan (52), an RBL Bank manager from Hanamkonda, and Ayesha Begum (30) of Karimnagar.

The other arrested include account holders Vibhudi Ramkumar (37) of Dharmaram in Peddapalli district, Natarla Srinivas (39) of Laxmipur in Jagtial district, Karre Raju (35) of Warangal, Kalleda Mahender (36), Kondra Narahari (37), and Kalleda Rajesh (27), all from Jagtial district.

Preliminary findings indicate that ₹12.25 crore was transacted through virtual accounts, while ₹125.80 crore flowed through mule accounts linked to RBL Bank.

The Police Commissioner Gaush Alam cautioned the public against sharing bank account details, ATM cards, or login credentials for small commissions, warning that such actions could attract criminal liability. Citizens were urged to report cyber fraud immediately by dialling the helpline 1930 or lodging complaints on the National Cybercrime Reporting Portal.

Further investigation is in progress, and officials said more arrests and disclosures are likely.



Cooling Water Camp Launched in Jawahar Nagar on Sri Rama Navami -- Budida Venkatesh

No Shortage of Gas or Petrol; Do Not Face Any Inconvenience: — Additional Revenue Collector Venka Reddy



“(Mandava Srisailam... Yadadri Bhuvanagiri District Bureau... Indian Chronicle... March 27): — Additional Revenue Collector Venka Reddy appealed to the people of the district, assuring them that there is no shortage of petrol, diesel, or cooking gas (LPG) in the district, and urged them not to make purchases out of panic. On Thursday, the Additional Collector held a meeting in his chamber with sales officers and petrol pump owners from across the district. Speaking on this occasion, the Additional Collector instructed sales officers to ensure that "No Stock" boards are not displayed anywhere in the district; he directed them to maintain advance stock bookings and ensure that stock is delivered within 24 hours. He also issued orders requiring that proper infrastructure facilities be maintained at all petrol pumps. He reiterated that there is absolutely no shortage of petrol, diesel, or cooking gas (LPG) anywhere in the district, noting that the entire fuel supply mechanism—from oil refineries to local depots—is functioning fully and efficiently. He stated that sufficient fuel reserves are available to meet the daily requirements of the district's residents. The temporary appearance of "No Stock" boards at some petrol pumps is a result of false rumors and the subsequent panic-buying of fuel by the public. Due to this fear-driven rush to purchase large quantities of fuel all at once, sales have surged to levels 2.5 to 3 times higher than normal. • Storing petrol or diesel in containers or cans is a violation of PESO regulations. This can lead to fire hazards. Strict action will be taken against any instances of illegal storage or black marketing. • The changes in advance payment policies by Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) have

caused only temporary inconveniences for local dealers; there is no shortage in supply. Appeal to the public from the Additional Collector: • Do not purchase fuel out of panic. Buy only the quantity you actually require. • Trust only official government announcements. Do not believe or forward fake news circulating on social media.

HYDRA PROTECTS 3,000 SQUARE YARDS OF PARK LAND IN MALKAJGIRI
