HPV Vaccination Programme Launched in Medchal–Malkajgiri District



“NARRA SRINIVAS REDDY (NSR), Medchal - Malkajgiri Staff Reporter, March 8, (Indian chronicle):“A Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccination programme aimed at protecting adolescent girls from cervical cancer was launched at the Malkajgiri Area Hospital in Medchal–Malkajgiri district on Sunday. The programme was inaugurated by Malkajgiri MLA Marri Rajasekhar Reddy. Speaking on the occasion, Marri Rajasekhar Reddy said that the HPV vaccine is highly effective in preventing cervical cancer among

girls. He urged parents to ensure that 14-year-old girls receive the vaccine and encouraged them to take advantage of the programme by bringing their children to nearby government health centres. Dr. C. Uma Gouri said that the HPV vaccination programme is being conducted only in medical institutions under the Directorate of Medical Education (DME) and Telangana Vaidya Vidhana Parishad (TVVP). The vaccine will be available on all working days from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm. The vaccination services are being



provided at GGH Quthbullapur/Area Hospital Malkajgiri, CHC Medchal and CHC Ghatkesar. Girls aged 14 years who were born between March 7, 2011 and March 8, 2012 are eligible to receive the vaccine. District Immunization Officer Dr. V. Kaushik said that a total of 72 girls were vaccinated on the first day. Of them, 42 girls received the vaccine at GGH Quthbullapur/Area Hospital Malkajgiri, 20 at CHC Medchal and 10 at CHC Ghatkesar. Deputy DMHO (Malkajgiri Division) Dr. M. Lavanya, Programme Officer CHI Dr. V. Kaushik, GGH Quthbullapur Superintendent Dr. G. Radha, CSRMO Dr. Sai Shobha, DCSRMO Dr. Pallavi, Pediatrics Professor Dr. Radha Kishan, Area Hospital Malkajgiri DCHS Dr. Sunitha, CHC Shamirpet Superintendent Dr. Shiva Kiran, PHC Malkajgiri Medical Officers Dr. Sushma and Dr. Madhuri, and UPHC Ekalavya Nagar Medical Officer Dr. Radha participated in the programme. Health officials also directed ASHA workers, ANMs and supervisors to identify eligible girls in their respective areas and ensure they are brought to nearby vaccination centres.

Three Arrested for Obstructing Police Duties in Noise Pollution Case

“NARRA SRINIVAS REDDY (NSR), Medchal - Malkajiri Staff Reporter, March 8, (Indian chronicle):“Jawahar Nagar: Three persons were arrested by Jawaharnagar Police for allegedly creating noise pollution and obstructing police

officials while they were performing their duties. According to police, on the night of March 7, 2026, at around 9:00 pm, Police Constable Aleti Mallesh (PC 12982) of Jawaharnagar Police Station was on patrol duty as in-charge of Patrol Car-1 along with driver Srinu and Home Guard 421. At about 12:30 am on March 8, a complaint was received through Dial 100 from a person identified as Sai Kumar stating that loud noise was being created in the CS Nagar area of Yellareddyguda. The patrol team immediately reached the spot and stopped a DJ sound system being played on an Ashok Leyland vehicle bearing registration number TS08UA1565. At that time, a person identified as D. Sandeep allegedly obstructed the police from performing their duties. When the police attempted to shift the vehicle to the police station, Sandeep interfered and forced the vehicle to be sent away, thereby hindering police action. Later, at around 1:36 am, another Dial 100 complaint was received from Chakali Venkatesham reporting continued noise pollution in the same area. Upon receiving the complaint, the patrol team along with Night Duty Officer J. Narsireddy, SI, and Blue Colt vehicle staff (PC 5977 and HG 1728) rushed to the location. At the scene, several individuals were allegedly creating loud noise and disturbance. During the intervention, Sandeep along with his associates Pawan and Vishal allegedly abused the police personnel using

offensive language, claimed to be local residents and obstructed the police. The trio reportedly grabbed a constable by the collar and pushed him while preventing the police from carrying out their duties. When the police attempted to detain them, the accused fled from the spot. Based on the incident, a case was registered against Sandeep, Pawan and Vishal under Sections 132, 221, 223(a), 292 read with 3(5) of the BNS, Section 3(10) of the Telangana Town Nuisance Act and Section 21/76 of the CP Act. Acting on reliable information that the three were present in Yellareddyguda, police took Sandeep, Pawan and Vishal into custody on Sunday morning. During interrogation, they reportedly admitted to the offence. Subsequently, they were formally arrested and remanded to judicial custody.



Central and State Governments Cheating the Unemployed: NV Rakesh

“Arvapalli Nagesh Khammam Staff Reporter March 8, (Indian Chronicle):“NV Rakesh, State President of the Progressive Youth League (PYL), alleged that the BJP-led central government and the Congress-led Telangana state government are neglecting unemployed youth and pushing them into hardship. He spoke at a district committee meeting held on Sunday at the Rama Narsayya Knowledge Center, Khammam, chaired by PYL District President Jatoth Prem Singh. “NV Rakesh criticized the Telangana Congress government, stating that within seven years of coming to power, it had promised 1.9 lakh jobs, but has so far failed to even acknowledge the unemployed. He said the job calendar has not been implemented, and unemployment allowances are not being provided. Youth who have



spent years preparing in coaching centers and libraries, aiming for employment, are left in despair due to lack of notifications. “He also condemned the central government led by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, pointing out that although it promised two crore jobs annually, it has failed to provide even two lakh jobs per year, prolonging the crisis. Rakesh said that youth are being misled on the basis of caste and religion, while the real issues remain unresolved. He highlighted that graduates and Ph.D. holders are still roaming the streets without employment—an unprecedented situation in the country. Rakesh further criticized the Congress government for failing to implement the Rajiv Youth Development Scheme, which promised financial assistance up to ₹3 lakh for five lakh beneficiaries. Even after a year, many eligible applicants have not received loans due to lack of transparency in the selection process. He demanded that the central and state governments immediately issue job notifications, honor all promises made to unemployed youth, implement the Rajiv Youth Development Scheme, enforce the job calendar, and provide unemployment allowances without delay. “NV Rakesh warned that if the governments fail to respond, the Progressive Youth League (PYL) will mobilize unemployed youth across the state for large-scale protests. The meeting was attended by District Secretary Jikkula Bharat, Vice Presidents C.H. Dharani Krishna, leaders Goddeti Ashok, Islavath Ramesh, Mamidala Venkatesh, Kotha Ramesh, and Maladi Venkatesh.
