## Rare Radiation Therapy Treats Throat Cancer at Yashoda Hospital

Given her advanced age and weak health condition, doctors initially considered only palliative care, as conventional treatment posed significant challenges. “After stabilizing her in the ICU, the medical team opted for MR LINAC-



based advanced radiation therapy, a cutting-edge technology that allows highly precise cancer treatment. She was treated using hypofractionated radiotherapy, delivering effective doses over a shorter period. “Within a few days, her condition improved significantly, and she gradually regained the ability to walk. A follow-up after three months confirmed that she had completely recovered from cancer, doctors said. “The hospital highlighted that this advanced treatment can be used for cancers such as brain tumors, prostate, lung, and liver cancers, often completing treatment within five days.
