Action Demanded Against Government Land Encroachment and Tax Evasion

Demand to Suspend Municipal Officials Supporting Irregularities Protest Deeksha Organized Under Nacharam JAC



“Nacharam, Indian chornical, March 5: “Leaders of the Nacharam JAC have demanded strict action against individuals involved in government land encroachment and commercial tax evasion in Nacharam. On Sunday, they staged a protest deeksha in front of the police station, expressing their opposition to the attitude of municipal officials.“On this occasion, Telangana Movement JAC Founding President Nalla Radhakrishna and Nacharam HMT Division JAC President Teki Rajasekhara stated that V. According to the layout, the surrounding areas include roads on two sides and neighboring plots—Plot No. 63 (308 sq. yards) and Plot No. 61 (370 sq. yards). However, the total land area has now reportedly increased to 639 square yards, raising questions about the extra 223 square yards.“They demanded an explanation and stated that if the 223 square yards is indeed government land, revenue officials should immediately take possession and utilize the land—worth approximately ₹5 crore—for constructing an HMT Nagar ward office.“The leaders further alleged that despite evasion of property tax amounting to ₹14 lakh related to five shops owned by V. Damodar Reddy and Kondal Reddy, no action has been taken by municipal officials. They de-

manded immediate suspension of the concerned officials.“They pointed out that even though Malkajgiri Municipal Corporation Commissioner Vinay Krishna Reddy had ordered strict action, including sealing buildings that fail to pay taxes—and has already taken action in several cases—no steps have been taken in this particular case, raising serious suspicions.“They also alleged that an illegal shed is being constructed behind the



shops without municipal permission. Additionally, they highlighted that a dilapidated building is being repaired and rented out again, posing serious risks. They questioned who would be responsible if any accident occurs due to structural failure, especially in the cellar area.“They stated that a representation regarding these issues had already been submitted a month ago to the Nacharam Circle DC and Uppal Zonal Commissioner, but no action has been taken so far, accusing officials of negligence.“They also criticized the inconsistency in enforcement, stating that while municipal laws say that houses below 100 square yards do not require permission, a 98-square-yard house was sealed in November citing lack of permission.“They questioned why no action is being taken against a commercial complex that has multiple violations—including tax evasion, unauthorized construction, unsafe cellar conditions, and dilapidated structures.“The leaders demanded a thorough inquiry into corrupt municipal officials and appropriate action against them, questioning whether there is one rule for the poor and another for the rich.“They further alleged that local political leaders Guntuka Krishna Reddy and Guntuka Shekhar Reddy supported V. Damodar Reddy and Kondal Reddy in getting a house sealed. They claimed that pressure was repeatedly applied on the owner to sell the land, causing fear and intimidation.“Prominent participants in the protest included Teki Jyothi, D.
