““UPPAL, May 10 (INDIAN CHRONICLE): Members of the Prajavani voluntary organization staged a unique protest demanding immediate repair of the damaged road near Bhagya D-Mart at Ramanthapur under Uppal Circle limits of the Malkajgiri Municipal Corporation. “The road has reportedly been in a severely damaged condition for a long time. Despite repeated appeals to the authorities, no action has been taken so far. As part of the protest, Prajavani representatives tied wooden logs to a bike and carried it along the damaged stretch of the road to highlight the difficulties faced by commuters. “Speaking on the occasion, the protesters questioned whether GHMC officials and public representatives, who regularly travel through the area, were unaware of the problem. They alleged that while authorities are keen on collecting taxes from the public, they are failing to show the same commitment towards resolving civic issues. “The protesters demanded that officials respond immediately and undertake road repair works without further delay. Take Strict Action Against Bandi’s Son; Bandi Sanjay Must Resign - Errabelli Swarna



“““Hanumakonda, May 10 (Indian Chronicle) : Errabelli Swarna, President of the Telangana Mahila Congress, demanded immediate and stringent legal action against the accused in the case involving allegations of sexual harassment of a minor girl. “As part of the state-wide dharna and protest programmes launched at her call, a protest was held on Sunday at the Congress Bhavan Junction in Hanumakonda under the leadership of District Mahila Congress President Banka Sarala. Participating in the protest as the chief guest, Swarna demanded strict legal action against Bandi Sai Bhageeradh, son of Union Minister Bandi Sanjay Kumar. “She stated that, taking moral responsibility for the incident, Bandi Sanjay should immediately resign from his post and be dismissed from the Union Cabinet. Protesters expressed their anger by displaying placards and later burned an effigy of the minister. “Swarna remarked that leaders who widely promote the slogan “Beti Bachao – Beti Padhao” across the country must be ac-

countable to the public in incidents of this nature. “She expressed doubts over the chances of justice for the victim while Bandi Sanjay continues to serve as Union Minister of State for Home Affairs. Emphasizing that the law must be equal for all, she said there should not be one law for those in power and another for ordinary citizens. “She alleged that while arrests are made promptly in POCSO cases involving common citizens, the pace of investigation appears slow in the case involving the Union Minister’s son, raising suspicions. She also mentioned the possibility of pressure being exerted on the police. “Swarna reiterated that justice must be ensured for the victim and that Bandi Sanjay should resign from his position, taking moral responsibility for the incident.

Establish a separate Ministry for BCs at the Central level. 6. Enact a comprehensive BC Protection Act. 7. Revisit and review the EWS reservation policy. 8. Implement the recommendations of the Rohini Commission. 9. Provide reservations in promotions and abolish the 'Creamy Layer' criterion. 10. Ensure adequate representation for BCs in the higher judiciary. Ramachandra Yadav requested Prime Minister Narendra Modi to provide a solution to their just demands.

No Deductions in the Name of “Talu”: Additional Collector Srinivas Reddy

“Rice millers asked to cooperate in paddy procurement” Increase the number of hamalis to speed up procurement “Inform the DSO first if there are doubts about quality” Additional Collector reviews paddy procurement process Khammam, May 10 (Indian Chronicle): “Additional Collector P. Srinivas Reddy instructed rice millers not to impose any deductions in the name of ‘Talu’ while accepting paddy at rice mills. A review meeting on paddy procurement was held on Sunday at the Collectorate meeting hall with officials of the Civil Supplies Department, rice millers, and representatives of the Millers Association. The meeting was chaired by Additional Collector P. Srinivas Reddy. Speaking at the meeting, the Additional Collector made it clear that rice millers should not make any deductions under the pretext of ‘Talu.’ He also directed millers not to reject paddy brought by farmers without valid reasons. He stated that if any paddy is suspected of not meeting FAQ (Fair Average Quality) standards, the matter should immediately be reported to the District Supply Officer (DSO). Upon receiving such information, a technical support committee comprising Agriculture Department officials would be sent to the rice mills to inspect the quality of the paddy. He clarified that paddy would be rejected only if the technical committee confirms that it does not meet the prescribed quality standards. He urged all rice millers to cooperate in the procurement process. To speed up paddy procurement operations, he instructed millers to increase the number of hamalis (loading workers). He emphasized that every rice miller should act responsibly to ensure that farmers do not face difficulties while selling their produce.
