

Congress stages bullock-cart rally in Karimnagar against fuel price hike

Leaders submit memorandum to Collectorate, accuse Centre of burdening common people.

KARIMNAGAR May 20 (Correspondent): Congress leaders and workers staged a large-scale protest in Karimnagar on Wednesday against the increase in petrol and diesel prices, alleging that the BJP-led NDA government at the Centre was imposing an additional burden on the common man.

The agitation, organised by the District Congress Committee and Corporation Congress at Indira Chowk, saw party leaders taking out a bullock-cart and rickshaw rally to draw attention to the impact of rising fuel prices on daily life.

Choppadandi MLA and District Congress Committee president Medipally Satyam, Corporation Congress president Vaidyula Anjan Kumar, SUDA Chairman Komatireddy Narendra Reddy, Congress leader Alphores Narendra Reddy and AMC Chairman Akula Narasaiah participated in the protest along with party cadres.

During the rally, senior Congress leaders rode on bullock carts while party activists carried motorcycles on cycle rickshaws before proceeding to the District Collectorate. A memorandum demanding an immediate rollback of fuel prices was later submitted to the Additional Collector.

Speaking on the occasion, Dr. Medipally Satyam alleged that the NDA government was pursuing anti-people policies and recalled Congress leader Rahul Gandhi's warning that fuel prices would rise after the completion of Assembly elections in various States.

He said the increase in petrol and diesel prices had severely affected poor and middle-class families and added that the Congress would intensify its agitation if the Centre failed to reduce fuel prices.

Corporation Congress president Vaidyula Anjan Kumar alleged that despite a fall in international crude oil prices, the Union government was continuing to burden the public through excise duty and cess. He said the rise in fuel prices had also triggered an increase in the cost of essential commodities.

SUDA Chairman Komatireddy Narendra Reddy accused the BJP government of favouring corporates at the expense of ordinary citizens and warned that the Congress would step up protests across the State if the Centre did not reconsider its policies.

Former MLA Katakam Mrutyunjayam said farmers, auto-rickshaw drivers, labourers and small traders were facing severe hardship due to the hike in fuel



prices and demanded immediate intervention by the Union government.

Two Permissions for One School.. Doubts Surround Excellent School

One school up to 7th class... another school name for 8th, 9th & 10th classes..? "Are Education Department officials trapped in a "bribe game"..? "How was permission granted for a petrol bunk near a school..?" "Serious allegations by former MPTC Konderu Ramu Manuguru, May 20 – Indian Chronicle" The functioning of "Excellent School," located beside the Edulla–Bayyaram main road in Pinapaka mandal, has become controversial. Several doubts are being raised among locals regarding school permissions, safety standards, and the operation of an educational institution near a petrol bunk. "When the local MEO was asked for clarification, he reportedly stated that "Excellent School" has permissions only up to 7th class, while permissions for 8th, 9th, and 10th classes were granted under the name "Bhasha School." However, former Uppaka MPTC Konderu Ramu questioned how two different schools could operate within the same premises under separate names. "He also alleged that study and conduct certificates issued to students are being provided under the name "Excellent School" itself. According to him, this could create confusion in official records, and he criticized education department officials for failing to conduct proper inspections. "Parents are also expressing serious concern over the presence of a petrol bunk adjacent to the school. They fear that having a fuel station in an area where hundreds of students commute daily could lead to potential dangers. Questions are also being raised about the safety measures in place to protect students during emergency situations. "Meanwhile, the local MEO reportedly stated that permission for the petrol bunk was granted only after the school had already received approval, which has further intensified the debate. "During the approval process for petrol bunks, strict norms related to educational institutions, hospitals, and densely populated areas are generally expected to be considered. Fire safety measures, minimum distance regulations, and traffic management are among the mandatory factors that should be examined. "Locals are now demanding a district-level inquiry into whether all rules and regulations were properly followed or whether permissions were granted due to official negligence. They are urging the government to take immediate action without compromising student safety.

Proper Planning and Precautionary Measures Can Effectively Tackle Flood Disasters: District Collector Divakar TS

“People in low-lying areas should be shifted to safer places in advance“All basic facilities must be ensured at flood relief camps“Priority should be given to closing manholes and identifying dangerous areas“District Collector reviews flood disaster preparedness* ““Khammam, May 20 Indian Chronicle: ““District Collector Divakar TS stated that flood disasters can be effectively managed through proper planning and advance precautionary measures. “On Wednesday, the District Collector participated in a flood preparedness review meeting held at the Collectorate office and conducted a detailed discussion with officials of Khammam and Yedulapuram municipalities along with other concerned departments. “Speaking on the occasion, District Collector Divakar TS said that based on past experiences, Khammam and Yedulapuram areas are highly vulnerable to floods. He directed officials to issue the first-stage warning when the water level reaches 16 feet, the second-stage warning at 19 feet, and the final warning at 24 feet. “He instructed officials to prepare a comprehensive plan to shift residents of low-lying



and flood-prone areas to safer places in advance. He emphasized that even if people do not cooperate, mandatory evacuation should be carried out whenever necessary to prevent loss of life. “The Collector directed officials to mentally prepare residents of vulnerable areas in advance and keep all essential materials ready at relief camps. Boats, life jackets, torch lights, zip covers, and other emergency equipment should be kept ready, and skilled swimmers should be identified and kept on alert. “He instructed officials to identify rehabilitation centers beforehand and ensure they are located close to flood-affected areas. Water levels in upstream and downstream regions should be monitored continuously during floods, he added. “The Collector observed that most casualties during floods occur due to the collapse of houses, trees, and electric poles. He directed officials to work with advance planning to completely prevent such incidents. “He ordered that every relief camp should be equipped with adequate food, sanitation, drinking water, electricity, and other essential facilities. “In municipal areas, manholes should be thoroughly inspected and properly covered, he said. Areas dug up for development works should be clearly demarcated to avoid accidents. “Officials were instructed to issue clear directions to field-level staff during floods to ensure effective response measures. He also directed departments to prepare a complete report on flood flow routes and inundation-prone areas. “The Collector stressed that sanitation management during floods should be highly efficient and officials should remain alert based on weather forecasts. With proper planning and precautionary measures, floods can be managed effectively, he said. “Khammam Municipal Commissioner Abhishek Agastya, Yedulapuram Municipal Commissioner Srinivas, and other concerned officials participated in the meeting. “Issued by District Public Relations Officer's Office, Khammam.

Where Are the Inspections on Private Schools in Nelakondapalli Mandal

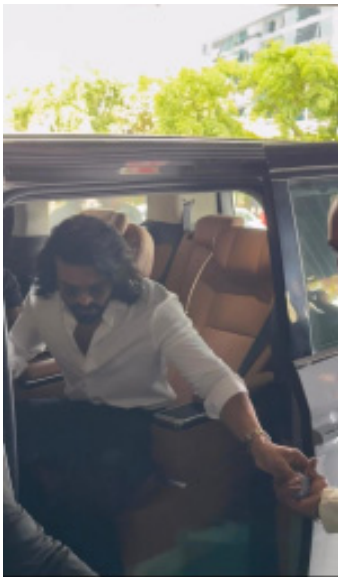
“Nelakondapalli, May 20 Indian Chronicle:”Private school managements in Nelakondapalli mandal are allegedly functioning as they please, with little moni-



toring from authorities. Parents and social activists are expressing concern over several irregularities in private schools, including excessive fees, compulsory purchase of books and uniforms from the schools themselves, and collection of admission fees against regulations. “There are also allegations of unsafe transportation, with nearly 20 students reportedly being transported in a single autorickshaw, putting children’s safety at risk. Many schools are said to employ unqualified teachers, while several institutions reportedly lack proper playgrounds and physical education teachers altogether. “Despite these issues, officials are accused of failing to conduct proper inspections or enforce educational norms. Critics say many schools have turned into commercial centers rather than institutions focused on quality education. “Parents allege that students are being pushed through rote learning methods merely to secure marks and pass percentages, without gaining proper subject knowledge. As a result, many students reportedly struggle to understand higher-level syllabus after moving on to further studies. “Parents and social activists are demanding that education department officials conduct inspections in all private schools and take strict action against institutions violating rules and regulations.

Enforcement action by Hyderabad Police against illicit tobacco trade in the city Rs1.10 crore worth of illegal tobacco seized; over 500 outlets booked in city-wide enforcement drive
