Interstate Chain Snatcher Arrested “Town ACP

“KHAMMAM, 22 MAY (INDIAN CHRONICLE):” “Khammam Urban Police arrested an interstate offender involved in chain snatching incidents targeting lone women in the city and remanded him to judicial custody, said Town ACP Ramanamurthy. “The ACP stated that during vehicle inspections conducted by Khanapuram Haveli Police near Sri Sri Circle on Saturday, police noticed a suspicious person riding a numberless Pulsar motorcycle. On seeing the police, he attempted to flee, but the officers caught and interrogated him. “The accused was identified as Patnala Venkata Durga Prabhu alias Akhil (29), a gym trainer from



Ankireddy Palem of Nallapadu village, Guntur district, Andhra Pradesh, and an interstate offender. “According to the ACP, on Friday in Road No. 7 of Sriram Nagar in Khammam city, the accused spotted a woman walking after getting down from an auto-rickshaw. Noticing the gold chain around her neck, he decided to snatch it. To avoid identification, he covered his face with a handkerchief and removed the number plate from his motorcycle. He also pasted a white sticker over the “Pulsar” brand name on the bike. “He stopped his motorcycle beside the woman, suddenly approached her, threatened to kill her, and forcibly snatched the gold chain from her neck. While escaping and attempting to mount his bike, the stolen gold chain slipped from his hand and fell to the ground. “Based on the victim’s complaint, a case was registered at Khanapuram Police Station. “The ACP further stated that the accused returned to Khammam again on Saturday with the intention of targeting lone women and elderly people in a similar manner. Cases had already been registered against him in several police stations in Andhra Pradesh, including: “Karlalalem in Bapatla

“District Collector conducts awareness meeting for political party representatives on the SIR mapping process.” KHAMMAM, 22 MAY (INDIAN CHRONICLE): “District Collector Divakar TS stated that representatives of political parties should extend full cooperation for the successful implementation of the SIR mapping process in a comprehensive and transparent manner to prepare an accurate voter list. “On Friday, the District Collector, along with Additional Collector P. Sreeja, Kalluru Sub-Collector Ajay Yadav, and Municipal Corporation Commissioner Abhishek Agastya, conducted a meeting with representatives of recognized political parties at the Khammam Collectorate conference hall. “Speaking on the occasion, District Collector Divakar TS said that a special SIR program is being conducted with the objective of ensuring that every eligible citizen’s name is included in the voter list while removing ineligible names. “He stated that the program will begin on June 25, 2026, and conclude with the publication of the final voter list on October 1, 2026. From June 25 to July 24, Booth Level Officers (BLOs) will visit every household and distribute pre-printed enumeration forms. “After the release of the draft voter list, claims and objections will be accepted, the Collector clarified. Following inquiries and the verification process, the final voter list will be published. “He mentioned that BLOs will visit every household at least three times for the distribution and collection of forms. Necessary precautions should be taken regarding deceased voters, migrated voters, and others. “He advised political parties to appoint Booth Level Agents (BLAs) and cooperate with the election machinery. Voters whose mapping is incomplete will need to submit any of the 12 types of documents, including birth certificates, passports, educational qualification certificates, caste certificates, and others. “The District Collector urged political party representatives to encourage all voters to participate in this special revision program and provide accurate information to help prepare a transparent and error-free voter list. “He also directed that the lists of Booth Level Agents should be submitted immediately. He explained that Form-6 would be used for the registration of new voters and Form-8 for corrections. He clarified that providing an Aadhaar number is completely optional. “If voters face difficulties in filling out the forms, they can make use of BLOs, the helpline, and the ECI Voters Portal services. Family members can also submit forms on behalf of voters residing in other states or abroad, he added. “The Collector answered the queries raised by representatives of various political parties in detail. He further stated that special training programs would be organized to provide complete awareness about the SIR process to BLAs once political parties appoint them. “Officials from election-related departments, members of various political parties, public representatives, and others participated in the meeting.
