

Minister Tummala Focuses on Expediting Irrigation Projects in Khammam

Review meeting held with officials under the chairmanship of Minister Uttam Kumar Reddy

Directions issued to accelerate pending project works

Land acquisition to be completed within two months

Acquisition of 74 acres could bring irrigation to one lakh acres

“Khammam, June 11 Indian Chronicle:”“State Agriculture Minister Tummala Nageswara Rao is taking special initiatives to ensure the completion of key irrigation projects aimed at meeting the irrigation needs of the erstwhile Khammam district and boosting agricultural development.”“After previously bringing pending irrigation issues in the district to the attention of Irrigation Minister N. Uttam Kumar Reddy through a formal letter, Minister Tummala on Thursday reviewed the progress of major projects during a high-level meeting held at Jalasoudha in Hyderabad under the chairmanship of Minister Uttam Kumar Reddy. He directed officials to expedite works and resolve bottlenecks without delay.”“The meeting was attended by Deputy Chief Minister Bhatti Vikramarka, Khammam District In-charge Minister Vakati Srihari, Minister Ponguleti Srinivasa Reddy, and legislators from the erstwhile Khammam district.”“Discussion on Key Irrigation Projects”“The review focused on several crucial projects, including:”“Seethamma Sagar Multipurpose Project”“Julurupadu Tunnel under the Sitarama Lift Irrigation Scheme”“Venkamma Cheruvu Flood Flow Canal”“Restoration of the Peddavagu Project”“Land acquisition for SRLP Package-10”“These projects are considered vital for irrigation expansion, agricultural growth, and water security in the district.”“Seethamma Sagar Awaiting Clearances”“Minister Tummala noted that nearly 60 percent of the work on the Seethamma Sagar Multipurpose Project, designed with a storage capacity of 36.57 TMC, has been completed. However, construction has stalled due to a case pending before the Supreme Court related to National Green Tribunal (NGT) proceedings.”“Once completed, the project is expected to provide irrigation to approximately 785,000 acres in the erstwhile Khammam district and generate 282 MW of hydropower. He urged officials to expedite the clearance process and facilitate the resumption of

work.”“Priority to Julurupadu Tunnel”“Highlighting the importance of the Julurupadu Tunnel under the Sitarama Lift Irrigation Scheme, the minister said the project has been pending for a long time. Its completion would significantly benefit the Illandu, Khammam, and Palair regions.”“He instructed officials to resolve land acquisition and forest clearance issues on a priority basis.”“8 Crore Sought for Venkamma Cheruvu Canal”“Tummala observed that the Venkamma Cheruvu Flood Flow Canal, initiated in 2008, remains incomplete, causing hardships to tribal and ayacut farmers.”“Since farmers have agreed to part with the required 72 acres of land, he requested the government to sanction 8 crore for land acquisition. Completion of the canal would help fill five minor irrigation tanks and benefit several surrounding villages.”“Funds Needed for Peddavagu Restoration”“The minister informed Deputy Chief Minister Bhatti Vikramarka that restoration works of the Peddavagu Project, damaged in July last year, are still pending

due to a financial approval of 3.20 crore awaiting clearance from the Finance Department.”“He also requested intervention to secure the release of 16 crore due from the Andhra Pradesh government. Officials were directed to take necessary follow-up action.”“Only 74 Acres Holding Up Irrigation to One Lakh Acres”“Officials informed the meeting that land acquisition cases involving 74 acres in Nagupalli village under the Yatalakunta Tunnel-Sattupalli Trunk Canal project are pending before the courts.”“Responding to this, Minister Tummala instructed authorities to resolve legal issues quickly and complete the acquisition process. He emphasized that acquiring these 74 acres alone could enable irrigation to nearly one lakh acres during the current agricultural season.”“Two-Month Deadline for Land Acquisition”“Minister Tummala directed officials to complete land acquisition for all irrigation projects in the district within two months and hand over the land to the concerned departments.”“He stressed the need for close coordination between



government departments and contractors to avoid delays in execution.”“The minister expressed confidence that the completion of these strategically important irrigation projects would provide water to lakhs of acres, enhance agricultural productivity, and strengthen the rural economy of the Khammam region.

Attack on Officials Preventing Illegal Soil Mining is Inhuman : Balne Jagan

Strict Action Must Be Taken Against Those Responsible for Assaulting Madannapet GPO Narasimha Swamy

“Narsampet/Warangal, June 11 (Indian Chronicle): BJP District Publicity Secretary Balne Jagan has strongly condemned the attack on Revenue Department officials who attempted to prevent illegal soil excavation activities in Madannapet village of Narsampet mandal, describing the incident as both unfortunate and deeply disturbing. “Speaking on the issue, Jagan stated that regardless of which party is in power, illegal soil and earth excavation activities cannot continue on such a scale without the knowledge or involvement of the concerned authorities. He remarked that it would be unrealistic to believe that the large-scale transportation of illegally excavated soil from water bodies, along with the unrestricted movement of tipper trucks and tractors through towns and villages, could occur without attracting official attention. He further observed that an administrative system that responds only after media reports or public complaints reflects a serious failure of governance and enforcement. “Jagan emphasized that intimidating, threatening, or attacking Irrigation and Revenue Department officials while they are performing their lawful duties to prevent illegal mining activities is a direct challenge to the rule of law. He expressed concern that if government officials themselves are unable to function safely, serious questions arise about the security and protection available to ordinary citizens. “Strongly condemning the indiscriminate attack on Madannapet GPO Officer Narasimha Swamy, he demanded the immediate identification of those responsible and called for stringent legal action against all individuals involved in the incident. “He further urged the District Collector and senior officials of the Revenue and Police Departments to conduct a thorough investigation into the matter, ensure that the perpetrators are brought to justice, and implement effective security measures to enable government officials to discharge their responsibilities without fear, intimidation, or obstruction in the future.

Raise Age Limit for Orphan Certificates

“Hyderabad, June 11 (Indian chronicle): Bokka Venkatayya, Founder State President of Anjali Telangana Orphans Rights Protection Organization and State Working President of the Orphans Rights Struggle Forum, has urged the Telangana government to address the issues related to the issuance of orphan certificates in the state. He stated that following protests held in 2017 demanding orphan certificates, the government issued GO Rt. No.124/2017, making orphan certificates available through the MeeSeva system. However, he expressed concern that the current age limit of 10 years for obtaining orphan certificates is causing severe difficulties for orphans pursuing higher education, including Intermediate, Degree, and Postgraduate studies. In view of the upcoming Telangana Public Service Commission (TGPSC) recruitment notifications, Venkatayya demanded that the age limit for orphan certificate eligibility be increased to 49 years. He also called upon orphans across the state to attend an upcoming meeting and voice their concerns regarding various issues affecting them. Venkatayya assured that all issues concerning the welfare and rights of orphans would be brought to the government's attention. Security Guard Seriously Injured After Colliding with Cattle; Alleges Neglect by Market Department Officials

“Khammam Nelakondapalli June 11 Indian Chronicle: “A security guard working under the Agricultural Market Committee suffered serious injuries after colliding with cattle while pursuing a suspicious vehicle during duty hours. The injured guard has alleged that officials of the concerned department have failed to respond to his situation and appealed for the release of his pending dues and investments. “According to details, Maragani Veerababu has been serving as a security guard at the Agricultural Market Committee check-post located at Painampalli under the jurisdiction of the Nelakondapalli Market Committee. Two days ago, while on duty at the check-post during the night, he noticed a suspicious vehicle that reportedly failed to stop at the checkpoint. In an attempt to intercept the vehicle, he chased it on his motorcycle. During the pursuit, he collided with cattle on the road and suffered severe injuries. “Veerababu is currently undergoing treatment at a private hospital in Khammam. He expressed disappointment that no officials from the concerned department have visited him or even inquired about his condition since the accident. “The injured guard further stated that he had borrowed money and spent nearly ₹1.5 lakh for the construction of the check-post and toll gate infrastructure. However, he alleged that the department has not yet reimbursed the expenditure. He said he continues to pay interest on the loans from his own pocket every month. “Veerababu claimed that the check-post has generated revenue far exceeding its targets, contributing lakhs of rupees in income. Despite this, he alleged that officials have remained indifferent even after his accident. “He appealed to the authorities to immediately clear his pending bills and salary dues and provide the support due to him. Attempts to obtain a response from Market Committee officials regarding the allegations were unsuccessful, as they were unavailable for comment.



Nepali Gang Theft Case in Hill Ridge Villas, Gachibowli.

“Cyberabad/ Gachibowli jun11: On 06.06.2026, a Nepali couple committed a theft in a villa located in Hill Ridge Villas, Gachibowli, Serilingampally, Ranga Reddy District, during the absence of the occupants. The elderly couple residing in the villa returned home on the evening of 07.06.2026 and noticed that a gold chain adorning a small idol was missing. Based on their complaint, a case was registered and investigation was taken up. On the evening of 08.06.2026, their son returned home and opened a locker using a key available with him. Upon inspection, it was found that approximately 7–8 kilograms of gold ornaments and about 1.5 kilograms of silver ornaments were missing from the locker. Upon receiving this information, the Commissioner of Police, Cyberabad, immediately pressed the Special Operations Team (SOT), Crime Teams, and local police into action. Multiple teams worked on all available leads and successfully tracked the movement of the accused. “Six police teams were dispatched to Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, and Uttarakhand. Details and photographs of the suspects were shared with the respective State Police authorities, and their assistance was sought. The special team constituted under the leadership of the Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad, for tracking Nepali criminal gangs also extended its support in the investigation. “Today, i.e., 09.06.2026, the Inspector of Police, Gachibowli, Sri P. Naresh, along with his team, and with the assistance of Sri SumendraMeena, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Rampur District, Jeeth Singh, SHO, Bilaspur Police Station, and their team, successfully apprehended three accused persons on Bilaspur Road in Rampur District, Uttar Pradesh. The entire stolen property was recovered intact. The arrested accused have been identified as “(1) Kamal Shahi, s/o Bal Bahadur Shahi, Age:32 Years of Birth: 1994, Resident of Ward No. 7, R.M. Mohanyal, District Kailali, Karnali Province, Country: Nepal. “(2)VimlaShahi @ BimalaShahi, w/o Kamal Shahi (Daughter of Katak Bahadur Shahi and Maya Devi Shahi), age: Born on the 12th day of the 09th month of the Nepalese Calendar Year 2056, N/o Ward No. 11, Panchpuri Municipality, Surkhet District, Karnali Province, Nepal. “(3)KalpanaShahi, daughter of Nara Bahadur Shahi, aged about 26 years, resident of Ward No. 4, R.M. Mohanyal, District Kailali, Karnali Province, Nepal. “M.O. The accused main MO is to targeted the High professional persons in High living villas and joined in their house by domestic employees and take opportunity and in the absence of inmates they broke open the house doors and lockers and committed theft of gold, cash and other valuable items. The absconding accused Suresh alias Suraj, a native of Nepal, brings persons from Nepal to Hyderabad and places them as domestic workers in expensive villas and houses. He gathers information through the workers he has placed regarding the times when no family members are present inside the house, and then commits



thefts based on that information. Similarly, in the present offence, with the assistance of Karan Bishwa Karma, Suresh alias Suraj placed domestic workers in Villa No. 73, Hill Ridge Villas, and committed theft in the said house. “Recovered property from accused: 1) Gold approximately 7 Kgs 837 grams. “2) Silver items approximately 1361 grams, 3) cash Rs 33,170/- “4) Mobile phones from them. “

The accused are being produced before the local court, and efforts are being made to bring them to Hyderabad on a transit warrant. During interrogation, the accused confessed that they had located the locker key kept beside the locker, opened it, removed all the jewellery, relocked the locker, and took away the key before fleeing. “Cyberabad Police Commissioner Dr. M. Ramesh, IPS, appreciated the police officers and staff who played a key role in the swift detection of the major theft case reported at Hill Ridge Villas and in the complete recovery of the stolen property. He stated that the coordinated efforts of the special teams, crime teams, technical staff, and local police led to the successful detection of the case within a short span of time. In recognition of their outstanding work in apprehending the accused and recovering the entire stolen property, the Commissioner announced cash rewards for the police personnel involved in the investigation. “The case was detected under the guidance of the Serilingampally Deputy Commissioner of Police Ch. Srinivas, IPS., with the active supervision and efforts of the Additional DCP, Serilingampally Zone, N. Uday Reddy, ACP Kalingarao, SHO, Gachibowli Balaraju, DI, Gachibowli PS, Naresh, Gachibowli PS crime team/staff.

Construction of Indiramma houses should be expedited: Yadadri Bhuvanagiri District Collector Anurag Jayanthi

He advised the relevant officials to conduct a transparent selection of beneficiaries. He suggested that the construction of Indiramma Houses, which are in progress, should be accelerated and steps should be taken to ensure that the beneficiaries receive money on time. He also said that the officials should work to increase employment opportunities in rural areas by effectively implementing the Employment Guarantee Scheme. A meeting of the District Level Consultative Committee (DCC) and District Level Review Committee (DLRC) was held under the chairmanship of the District Collector at the Collectorate on Thursday. On this occasion, the District Collector reviewed the performance of the banking sector for the financial year 2025-26 and unveiled the Annual Credit Plan (ACP) 2026-27. In the financial year 2025-26, banks in the district disbursed loans of ₹7,997.00 crore against the annual credit plan target of ₹6,717.58 crore, recording a progress of 119.05 percent. In the priority sector, loans of ₹5,656.59 crore were disbursed against the target of ₹5,392.24 crore, recording a progress of 104.90 percent. In the agriculture sector, loans of ₹4,893.37 crore were disbursed against the target of ₹4,341.82 crore, recording a progress of 112.70 percent. In the MSME sector, ₹694.37 crore loans were disbursed, while the small industries sector registered a growth of 226.62 percent. The distribution of priority sector housing loans and education loans also continued to be satisfactory. In the non-priority sector, ₹2,340.41 crore loans were disbursed against the target of ₹1,325.34 crore, recording a



growth of 176.59 percent. Especially in the personal loan segment, an achievement of 413.64 percent was recorded. Later, the District Collector unveiled the annual loan plan for the financial year 2026-27. A total loan plan of ₹7,848.60 crore was prepared for the district, which represents a growth of 16.84 percent compared to the target of the previous year. ₹6,337.71 crore was allocated for the priority sector, out of which ₹4,978.44 crore was allocated for the agriculture sector and ₹1,182.53 crore for the MSME sector. ₹2,766.72 crore has been proposed for crop loans in the agriculture sector. An annual loan target of ₹1,182.53 crore has been proposed for the MSME sector. In addition, special allocations have been made for education loans, housing loans, social infrastructure and renewable energy sectors. It was revealed in the meeting that loans of ₹239.02 crore have been disbursed to 14,367 beneficiaries under the Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana as part of the implementation of government-sponsored schemes. “Under the DRDA-SERP SHG Bank Linkage Programme, loans of ₹650.88 crore were disbursed against a target of ₹611.18 crore, achieving 106.50 percent progress, while loans of ₹123.28 crore were disbursed to MEPM SHGs, achieving 121.24 percent of the target. Officials said that 7,367 applications were sanctioned in the first phase, 4,318 in the second phase and 1,305 in the third phase under the Pradhan Mantri SWANidhi Scheme. “Speaking on the occasion, the District Collector suggested that banks should complete the targets of the prestigious schemes of the Central Government like PMEGP, PM Vishwakarma, PM SWANidhi and Jan Suraksha Schemes on time.
