Success Is Possible Only by Overcoming Mental Stress; Drug Abuse Destroys Life: Dr. Kambhampati Narayana Rao

“Khammam, June 26 Indian Chronicle:” “On the occasion of the International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking, an awareness programme was organized jointly by Telangana Graduates Youth Association and Sri Raksha Hospitals with the support of Mera Yuva Bharat. The programme was attended by Sri Raksha Hospitals Chairman Dr. Gongura Venkateswarlu and State President of the Psychiatrists Association Dr. Kambhampati Narayana Rao as chief guests. Addressing the gathering, Dr. Gongura Venkateswarlu said that drug addiction among youth is eroding human values and contributing to the increasing crime rate in society. He observed that many young people fall victim to drugs without realizing that what begins as a casual habit can eventually destroy their entire lives. He pointed out that drug abuse is no longer confined to cities and towns but has also spread to rural areas. He noted that both the Central and State Governments are conducting extensive awareness programmes to protect people from the menace of drugs. He urged young people to actively participate in such programmes and help eliminate the drug problem at its early stages before it spreads further across the country. He advised youth to stay away from intoxicants, develop social responsibility, and focus on achieving their life goals, thereby bringing pride to their families and the nation. Speaking on the occasion, Dr. Kambhampati Narayana Rao said that addiction to drugs can lead young people to lose their lives and jeopardize the future of the country. He warned that becoming dependent on drugs due to mental stress is equivalent to moving closer to death. He further stated that those who have become addicted to drugs should immediately seek medical help, as rehabilitation centres can help them regain a healthy and productive life. Mera Yuva Bharat Account Officer Bhanu Chander emphasized that youth should focus on their goals and aspirations rather than harmful addictions. He said



that stress can be effectively managed through yoga, physical exercise, and meditation. He cautioned that using drugs under the misconception that they relieve stress can ultimately destroy not only an individual's life but also the well-being of their family. Massive irregularities in KUDA land auction... Dasyam Vinay Bhaskar



“Hanamkonda, June 26 (Indian Chronicle): Former Government Chief Whip and former Warangal West MLA Dasyam Vinay Bhaskar alleged on Friday that the Congress government is repeatedly making accusations against the opposition while neglecting governance and failing to fulfill its election promises. Speaking at a press conference held at the BRS Hanamkonda district office in Balasamudram, he charged the government with failing to implement its key pledges, including the “420 promises” and the “six guarantees.” “He alleged that instead of focusing on development, the government is fostering corruption within the Kakatiya Urban Development Authority (KUDA) and pressuring officials to engage in irregularities. Vinay Bhaskar questioned

why the recent KUDA land auction was conducted offline when most government processes have shifted to online platforms, and he demanded the cancellation of the auction.” “The former MLA alleged that the government is targeting opposition parties through legal cases, demolitions, and intimidation, while simultaneously ignoring development issues. Citing the Yadav Nagar–Reddypuram route, he pointed out that a tank is being filled in violation of environmental laws, posing a threat to birds, aquatic life, and the local ecosystem. He demanded that double-bedroom houses be allocated to eligible local beneficiaries without displacing poor families. While welcoming the distribution of houses built during the previous BRS government’s tenure, he urged the government to ensure they reach genuine local beneficiaries.” “Speaking at the press conference, former KUDA Chairman Marri Yadav Reddy alleged serious irregularities in the KUDA land parcel auction held on June 21. He stated that municipal officials had originally transferred this land—located behind the Balasamudram Press Club—to KUDA. According to him, while the current market value of the land ranges from approximately ₹1.30 lakh to ₹1.50 lakh per square yard, it was auctioned at a rate of only ₹66,000–₹69,000 per square yard.” “He alleged that only 11 to 13 bidders participated in the auction and that a syndicate manipulated the bidding process to keep prices artificially low, resulting in a loss of approximately ₹50 crore to KUDA. He claimed there were ulterior motives behind the auction. He demanded explanations from the KUDA Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and officials regarding the process, including the reason why two specific plots were not auctioned.” “Alleging that the auction was conducted in violation of established norms, Marri Yadav Reddy demanded the cancellation of the sale. He demanded a CBI or government inquiry into this auction. He warned that if the government failed to order an impartial probe, the BRS would launch phased public protests.” “Former Deputy Mayor Sirajuddin, former Minority Commission member Darshan Singh, former corporators Soda Kiran, Bongu Ashok Yadav, Jorika Ramesh, and Kusuma Lakshmi Narayana, along with several BRS leaders and party activists, attended the press conference.

BLOs Must Report to Duty Immediately: Mekala Sarangapani Demands

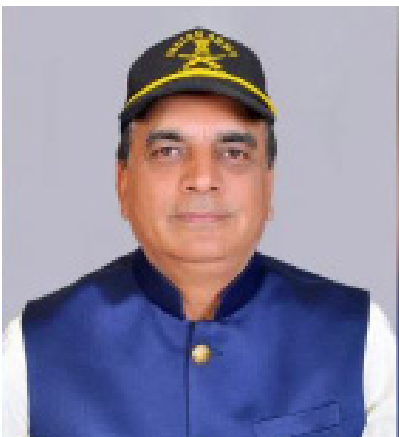

Congress leaders dismiss BRS allegations against Sridhar Babu, throw challenge over corruption claims

SUDA Chairman Komatireddy Narendra Reddy and former MLA Arepalli Mohan defend Minister D. Sridhar Babu, accuse BRS of spreading baseless allegations and misgovernance during its decade-long rule.

Karimnagar June 26 (Correspondent): Senior Congress leaders on Friday strongly rejected the allegations levelled by BRS leaders against Telangana Minister D. Sridhar Babu, describing them as politically motivated and devoid of evidence.

Addressing a press conference at Chemists Bhavan in Karimnagar, SUDA Chairman Komatireddy Narendra Reddy and former Government Whip Arepalli Mohan defended the Minister's integrity and challenged the BRS to substantiate its allegations of corruption in the proposed Future City project.

Mr. Mohan said former Minister Jeevan Reddy should make public any evidence supporting his allegations against Mr. Sridhar Babu. He declared that he would quit politics permanently if the charges were proved, and challenged Mr. Jeevan Reddy to do the same if they failed to establish the allegations.

Accusing the previous BRS government of encouraging illegal sand mining, Mr. Mohan alleged that the practice began during its tenure and questioned why the Dalit Bandhu scheme had remained largely confined to Huzurabad instead of being implemented across the State. He also blamed the previous regime for pushing Telangana into heavy debt during its 10-year rule.



Mr. Mohan asserted that Mr. Sridhar Babu's honesty was well known to the people of the State and urged political opponents to avoid making unsubstantiated allegations. He also criticised the previous government over law and order issues and welfare implementation.

Speaking on the occasion, Mr. Narendra Reddy alleged that the BRS was targeting the Congress government to regain political relevance. He described the Kaleshwaram Lift Irrigation Project as a symbol of corruption under the previous regime and accused BRS leaders of shielding those involved in illegal sand mining and contractor-related irregularities.

He further claimed that the Congress government was implementing its welfare commitments, including Indiramma housing, 200 units of free electricity and distribution of fine rice, and said Mr. Sridhar Babu was working sincerely for the State's development under the leadership of Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy.

Several Congress leaders, including Karimnagar Market Committee Chairman Akula Narasaiah, RGPS State Co-convenor Uppala Anjan Prasad, Urban Bank Chairman Karra Rajasekhar, Minority Cell district president M.D. Tajuddin and NSUI leader Potharam Surrender, were present at the press conference.

The exhibition will feature displays related to agriculture, horticulture, animal husbandry, fisheries, dairy development, organic farming, farm mechanization, modern cultivation techniques, value-added agricultural products and various government welfare schemes.“He urged farmers from Khammam district and neighboring regions to make full use of the event to learn about the latest agricultural technologies and innovative farming methods.“The Collector directed officials to organize live demonstrations of modern agricultural machinery and special demonstrations on high-yield cultivation practices. He also instructed them to conduct awareness sessions with agricultural scientists and experts so that farmers can directly interact with specialists and get answers to their queries.“To ensure a hassle-free experience for visitors, officials were directed to provide adequate drinking water, toilets, medical camps, food facilities, information centers, sufficient service counters and spacious parking arrangements. Minister Tummala Inspects Palm Oil Factory Construction at Kallurugudem



“Directs Officials to Expedite Works for August Commissioning”**“Palm Oil Cultivation a Boon for Telangana Farmers: Minister Tummala”**“Khammam, June 26, Indian Chronicle:”“Telangana Agriculture Minister Tummala Nageswara Rao said that palm oil cultivation has emerged as a boon for the farming community in Telangana and that the state is poised to become the palm oil hub of India.”On

Friday, the minister, accompanied by Sathupalli MLA Matta Ragamayee, inspected the construction works of the new palm oil processing factory being established at Kallurugudem in Vemsur Mandal of Khammam district. “Speaking on the occasion, Minister Tummala stated that under the leadership of Chief Minister Revanth Reddy, Telangana has secured the top position in the country in terms of expansion of palm oil cultivation. “He noted that while palm oil is currently cultivated in about 1.5 million acres across India, the country needs to expand cultivation to nearly 7 million acres to achieve self-sufficiency in edible oil production. Telangana alone has recorded a 36 percent increase in palm oil cultivation, placing it at the forefront nationally. “The minister pointed out that India spends enormous amounts annually on edible oil imports. He said that increasing the import duty on palm oil by the Central Government would encourage domestic production and provide better prices to farmers. He recalled that the Telangana Government recently urged Union Ministers Shivraj Singh Chouhan and Pralhad Joshi in New Delhi to raise import duties in the interest of farmers and national self-reliance. “Tummala stated that the current price of Fresh Fruit Bunches (FFB) stands at ₹23,852 per tonne and urged the Centre to announce a minimum guaranteed price of ₹25,000 per tonne. “The minister informed that while two palm oil processing factories are already functioning in Bhadrachalam Kothagudem district and another is available to farmers at Narmetta in Siddipet district, new processing units are under construction at Kallurugudem and Konijerla in Khammam district, Beechpally in Gadwal district, Incharla in Mulugu district, and in Peddapalli and Wanaparthy districts. “He directed officials to accelerate the construction works and ensure that the Kallurugudem factory is completed and made operational by August this year for the benefit of farmers. “Minister Tummala further said that under the people-centric governance of Chief Minister Revanth Reddy, schemes such as Rythu Bharosa, Rythu Bima, and free power supply are providing strong support to palm oil farmers. He expressed confidence that expansion of palm oil cultivation to 10 lakh acres would not only enhance the state's green cover but also play a significant role in Telangana's economic growth. “Appealing to farmers, the minister urged them to take up palm oil cultivation as part of crop diversification efforts. “Officials from OilFed and the Horticulture Department also participated in the inspection program.

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Gangula seeks immediate release of irrigation water Calls for farmers to join Maha Dharna on Sunday, alleges government ignored repeated appeals.

Karimnagar June 26 (Correspondent): Former Minister and Karimnagar MLA Gangula Kamalakhar has urged farmers to participate in a Maha Dharna on Sunday to demand the immediate release of irrigation water to villages in the Karimnagar constituency.

Speaking at a meeting of farmers and local public representatives at his office on Friday, Mr. Kamalakhar alleged that despite appeals made a week ago, the State government had failed to release water through the Achampalli sluice from the Yellampalli Project flood canal to the Mid Manair Reservoir.

He demanded that irrigation water be released to fill tanks and provide irrigation to farmers in seven villages of Kothapalli mandal, including Nagul Malyala, Bavupeta, Kamanpur, Kondapur, Elgandal and Sriramulapalle. Claiming that farmers were being pushed into distress due to the delay, he said they had no option but to intensify their agitation.

Mr. Kamalakhar urged farmers to join the protest in large numbers and criticised the government for, as he alleged, prioritising the trans-



fer of water to Rajahmundry while neglecting Telangana's irrigation requirements. He also recalled that during the previous BRS government led by K. Chandrashekar Rao, water was supplied through the Medigadda project, enabling tanks to remain full during the summer months.
