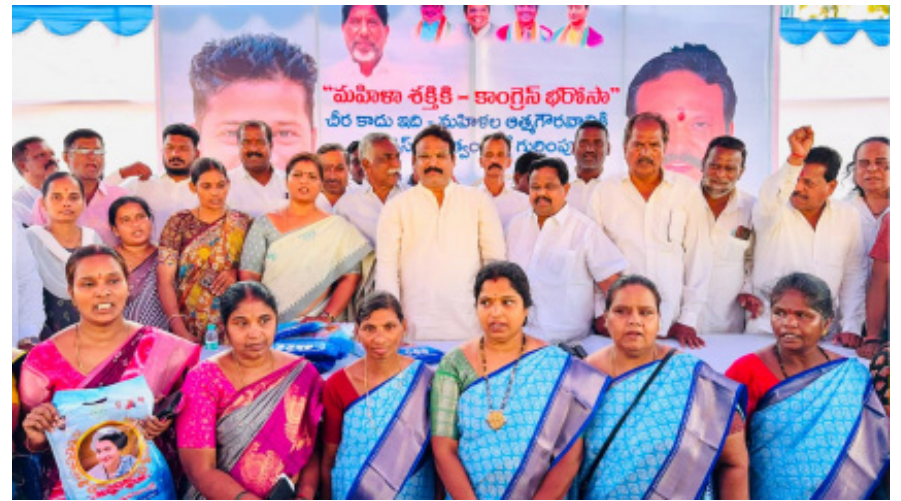


CANTONMENT M.L.A SRI GANESH DISTRIBUTES SAREES TO WOMEN ON TELANHANA FORMATION DAY

BJP Gave Telangana and Is Driving Its Development: Khammam BJP President

“Khammam, June 2 Indian Chronicle:“Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) Khammam District President Nelluri Koteswara Rao asserted that it was the BJP that fought for the formation of Telangana, ensured its creation, and is now leading its development. He made these remarks during the Telangana State Formation Day celebrations held grandly at the BJP district office in Khammam on Tuesday. “Hoisting the national flag on the occasion, Koteswara Rao extended his heartfelt greetings to the people of Telangana, statehood movement activists, and the families of martyrs on behalf of the BJP. “BJP’s Role in Telangana Statehood” Speaking on the occasion, he said that although India attained independence in 1947, Telangana achieved true freedom only on June 2, 2014, with the formation of the state. He stated that while many parties claim credit for Telangana’s creation, it was the BJP that consistently supported the demand from 1947 to 2014 and played a decisive role in Parliament in ensuring statehood. “Koteswara Rao criticized former Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru for allegedly neglecting Telangana during the Razakar period and claimed that Telangana’s liberation came through Operation Polo led by Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel on September 17, 1948. He further alleged that Nehru later merged Telangana with Andhra Pradesh against the wishes of the

people. “Referring to the 1969 Telangana agitation, he accused the Congress government under Indira Gandhi of suppressing the movement, and also alleged that the UPA government delayed Telangana statehood for a decade despite coming to power in 2004. “Commitment to “One Vote – Two States” “The BJP leader said the party never compromised on the Telangana issue and remained committed to its 1997 Kakinada resolution advocating “One Vote – Two States.” He recalled that under former Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee, the states of Uttarakhand, Jharkhand, and Chhattisgarh were created smoothly, demonstrating the BJP’s commitment to administrative efficiency. “He praised BJP leaders such as Bandaru Dattatreya, Indrasena Reddy, Vidyasagar Rao, Ale Narendra, and G. Kishan Reddy for their contributions to the Telangana movement. He also highlighted the role of late Sushma Swaraj, saying her strong support in Parliament helped make the Telangana Reorganisation Bill possible. “Criticism of BRS and Congress “Koteswara Rao alleged that while Telangana was achieved through the sacrifices of thousands of activists, a few political families benefited the most, accumulating vast wealth while movement activists and martyrs’ families were neglected. “He criticized the previous



BRS government, claiming that despite large budget allocations and borrowings during its tenure, insufficient attention was given to the welfare of Telangana movement activists. He also took aim at the current Congress government led by Chief Minister Revanth Reddy, accusing it of administrative failures and financial mismanagement. “Telangana’s Growth Under Prime Minister Modi” The BJP leader credited Prime Minister Narendra Modi and the Central Government for Telangana’s economic growth, stating that the state’s strong performance in per capita income and paddy procurement was made possible through central support. “He claimed that a significant share of the paddy procured by the Centre came from Telangana and challenged Congress leaders to deliver better support to farmers. He assured

Government Accused of Burdening Employees Through Salary Deductions BJP Leader Prabha Goud

“Hyderabad, June 02 (Indian Chronicle): BJP Telangana State Official Spokesperson Prabha Goud alleged that the Congress government is unfairly burdening employees by deducting amounts from their salaries in the name of the Employees Health Care Trust (EHCT). Addressing a media conference in Hyderabad

He warned that stringent action would be taken against anyone demanding money or attempting to exploit beneficiaries in the name of house allotments. passengers on RTC buses to date. “With the twin objectives of fostering women’s empowerment and providing cooking gas cylinders at affordable rates, the government resolved to offer subsidized LPG cylinders for ₹500 under the Mahalakshmi Scheme. As part of this initiative, 1,28,282 beneficiaries in our district were identified as eligible under the Mahalakshmi Scheme; subsequently, 8,09,387 cylinders were distributed, and a total subsidy amount of ₹25.91 crores was deposited directly into their bank accounts. Animal Husbandry Department: “As part of the 99-day program of the People’s Administration Progress Plan, treatment camps for uterine diseases of cattle and exhibition of good breed calves born through artificial insemination were organized in 15 mandals of the district on 08.05.2026. In this program, treatment of uterine diseases in 1 thousand 57 cattle and exhibition of 285 good breed calves were organized, and awareness was created on the precautions to be taken in animal nutrition in summer. A total of 554 farmers benefited from this program. This year, 41 tons of animal feed seeds were supplied to farmers at a subsidy of 75% through the Central Government’s Mini Kit Scheme. “Two mobile veterinary clinics are functioning continuously under the Aler and Bhuvanagiri constituencies with a toll-free number of 1962. Fisheries Department: There are 161 big tanks, 469 small tanks and 20 tanks in the Musi river basin. About 11 thousand 654 fishermen are earning their livelihood through 178 fisheries industrial societies and 12 women fisheries industrial societies in the district. “In the year 2025-26, 2 crore 80 lakh fish fry and 10 lakh shrimp fry were released in 630 tanks by the Fisheries Department. “Handloom and Textiles Department: “7 thousand 636 handloom looms and 2 thousand 240 power looms have been geo-tagged in the district. “ The Telangana Government has implemented the “Netannaku Chuthu” scheme for handloom and allied workers from April 2025 for the years 2025-26 and 2026-27. Under this scheme, 10,790 handloom and allied workers have been registered and Rs. 4 crore 34 lakhs have been released. “10,686 eligible handloom workers have been included in the Netannaku Bhima scheme. Rs. 9 crore 95 lakhs have been deposited in the accounts of the nominees for the families of 189 weavers who died due to various reasons. “Industries: Since the inception of the district, 1,050 Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Divyangs have been sanctioned subsidy of Rs. 27 crore 9 lakhs. Under the PMEGP scheme, 226 applications have been sanctioned for Rs. 8 crore 55 lakhs in the financial year 2025-26. Rs. has been sanctioned through banks. “Panchayat Raj Engineering Department: During the year 2024-25, 20 road construction works have been sanctioned with CRR funds (02) works have been completed and the remaining works are in progress and 67 Anganwadi building construction works have been sanctioned with Rs. 5 crore 36 lakhs and (02) works have been completed and the remaining works are in progress under MGNREGS. Roads and Buildings: Under State Plan Funds, 9 road works and 4 bridges have been sanctioned with Rs. 713 crore 56 lakhs and 181.2 km have been sanctioned and 81.20 km have been completed and the remaining works are in progress. “Under Non-Plan Funds, 65 works (300.10 km) have been sanctioned with Rs. 199 crore 56 lakhs and 225.15 km have been completed and the remaining works are in progress and under Railway Safety, Road Under Bridge at Aler with Rs. 11 crores Sanjurai, work is in progress. Prohibition and Excise Department:- “As part of the public administration program, awareness seminars were organized in schools and colleges about the ill effects of drug addiction. Also, inspections were conducted at Pantangi Gudur Toll Plaza and as part of that, cases were registered against people transporting ganja. A case was registered against people transporting ganja at Pantangi Toll Plaza under Ramannapet station limits and 60 kg of dry ganja was seized from them, four people were arrested and an auto vehicle was seized. As part of the Telangana Vana Mahotsavam program, 54 thousand 500 date palm / date palm saplings were planted in the district in the year 2025. As part of the welfare program for the gita workers in the district, (05) gita workers, (05) permanently disabled people and (24) temporary An ex-gratia of Rs. 50 lakh 24 thousand was provided to the disabled. Karimnagar AIMIM split widens; Eid Milap exposes factional war

Old guard rallies behind former Deputy Mayor; cadre accuse leadership of side-lining loyal workers.

KARIMNAGAR June 2 (Correspondent): The simmering factional feud within the Karimnagar unit of the All India Majlis-e-Ittehadul Muslimeen (AIMIM) has burst into the open, with rival groups publicly displaying their strength during Eid Milap celebrations held in the city. What had remained an internal tussle for months was laid bare as leaders and workers aligned with competing camps organised separate programmes, triggering intense political discussion over the party's future in Karimnagar. According to party insiders, a majority of the old cadre continue to remain loyal to the camp led by a former Town President and former Deputy Mayor. The presence of several senior workers and supporters at events associated with the former leadership camp has fuelled speculation that the current leadership is facing growing resistance from within. The unrest is said to stem from allegations that veteran party workers are being ignored in organisational matters while newcomers are being given key responsibilities. Senior activists have reportedly expressed resentment over what they describe as the marginalisation of leaders who stood by the party during difficult times. The internal discord has also revived debate over AIMIM's declining political fortunes in Karimnagar. Party workers point out that the organisation, which once had seven corporators in the Municipal Corporation, is now represented by only two. Critics blame factionalism and weak organisational management for the decline. Political observers warn that unless the party leadership intervenes to bridge the widening gap between the rival camps, AIMIM could face fresh challenges in the upcoming municipal and local body elections. With both groups now openly asserting their influence, concerns are mounting over the impact of the feud on the party's grassroots support base. Attempts to contact local AIMIM leaders for their response to the reported differences did not elicit an immediate reply.



Argentina Rewrites the Global Playbook on Nicotine

Hyderabad: Countries shift from WHO recommendations to FDA-Style regulatory frameworks. For India, still deliberating its own tobacco control framework, the signal is hard to ignore. "In a striking policy reversal, Argentina formally lifted their bans on e-cigarettes and heated tobacco products in April-May 2026, joining a growing bloc of nations abandoning prohibition in favour of smart, evidence-based regulation. For India, still deliberating its own tobacco control framework, the signal is hard to ignore. "Argentina's case is the starkest. After 15 years of an outright ban, Buenos Aires acknowledged the uncomfortable truth: prohibition hadn't reduced consumption, it had simply driven it underground. With no quality controls, no age verification, and no traceability, the black market thrived. The government replaced the ban with comprehensive regulatory architecture: mandatory product registration, strict ingredient disclosure, and a traceability mechanism explicitly designed to block sales to minors. The message from Buenos Aires was blunt- bans don't work; accountability does. "Bangladesh followed suit, implementing parallel controls as it opened its market, signaling that even conservative regulatory environments are pivoting toward managed access over failed prohibition. "The FDA Model Goes Global" The intellectual backbone of this shift is the U.S. Food and Drug Administration's risk-tiered regulatory framework, increasingly seen as the global gold standard over the WHO's blanket prevention approach. The FDA doesn't treat all nicotine products as equivalent. Instead, it differentiates by harm level, subjecting each product to rigorous scientific scrutiny before market access is granted. Of roughly 26 million applications, only 34 smokeless tobacco products have received approval, hardly a free-for-all.
