## Congress protests LPG price hike in Karimnagar Leaders stage 'Vanta Varpu' at Indira Chowk, accuse Centre of burdening poor and middle-class families.

KARIMNAGAR June 8 (Correspondent): The District Congress Committee on Monday staged a protest at Indira Chowk in Karimnagar against the recent increase in domestic LPG cylinder prices, accusing the BJP-led NDA government at the Centre of imposing an additional financial burden on poor and middle-class households.

As part of the agitation, Congress leaders and activists organised a 'Vanta Varpu' programme, cooking food on traditional firewood stoves placed on the roadside. Empty LPG cylinders and placards carrying anti-BJP slogans were displayed to highlight the impact of rising cooking gas prices on household budgets.

Addressing the gathering, Karimnagar MLA Medipally Satyam, SUDA Chairman Komatireddy Narendra Reddy and Urban Bank Chairman Karra Rajasekhara criticised the Centre for increasing LPG prices by ₹29 and alleged that the move would further strain family finances already affected by rising

fuel and commodity costs.

The speakers contended that repeated increases in petrol, diesel and cooking gas prices had triggered a rise in the cost of essential commodities, making life difficult for economically weaker sections and the middle class. They said the Congress would continue its agitation against the price hike and demand immediate relief for consumers.

The leaders also questioned the silence of BJP MPs from Telangana on the issue and urged them to take up the concerns of the people with the Union government. They alleged that while the Centre was projecting a vision of a developed India, its policies were adversely affecting ordinary citizens.

Referring to the Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana, the Congress leaders claimed that rising refill costs had reduced the scheme's effectiveness and forced some households to return to firewood-based cooking. They demanded a rollback of the LPG price increase and



restoration of subsidy benefits.

Following the protest, Congress leaders submitted a memorandum to the District Collector, urging the Centre to reduce LPG prices and provide relief to

consumers.

A large number of Congress leaders, Youth Congress members, Mahila Congress representatives and party workers participated in the demonstration.

## Allocate Land and Funds for Uppal Degree College—Parameshwar Reddy Appeals to CM Revanth Reddy

""UPPAL , JUNE 8 (INDIAN CHRONICAL): Uppal Constituency Congress Party In-charge Mandumula Parameshwar Reddy and former corporator Mandumula Rajitha Parameshwar Reddy have appealed to Revanth Reddy to allocate land and funds for the construction of a permanent government degree college in Uppal. ## Collector Assures Swift Redressal of Public Grievances at Prajavani

**Personally receives petitions from elderly and differently abled persons; 144 applications submitted during Monday's programme.**

KARIMNAGAR June 8 (Correspondent): District Collector Chitra Mishra on Monday assured citizens that grievances submitted through the Prajavani programme would be addressed promptly and directed officials to ensure expeditious disposal of pending applications and files.

At the weekly public grievance redressal programme held at the Collectorate auditorium, Ms. Mishra received petitions from members of the public and interacted with applicants to understand their concerns. She paid special attention to elderly persons and persons with disabilities, personally approaching them to receive their representations and instructing officials concerned to initiate immediate action.



Emphasising the importance of responsive governance, the Collector directed officials to examine every petition carefully and identify appropriate solutions. She also instructed departments not to keep files pending and to clear them without delay.

## Residents Stage Protest Demanding Resolution of Civic Issues in Bhavani Nagar

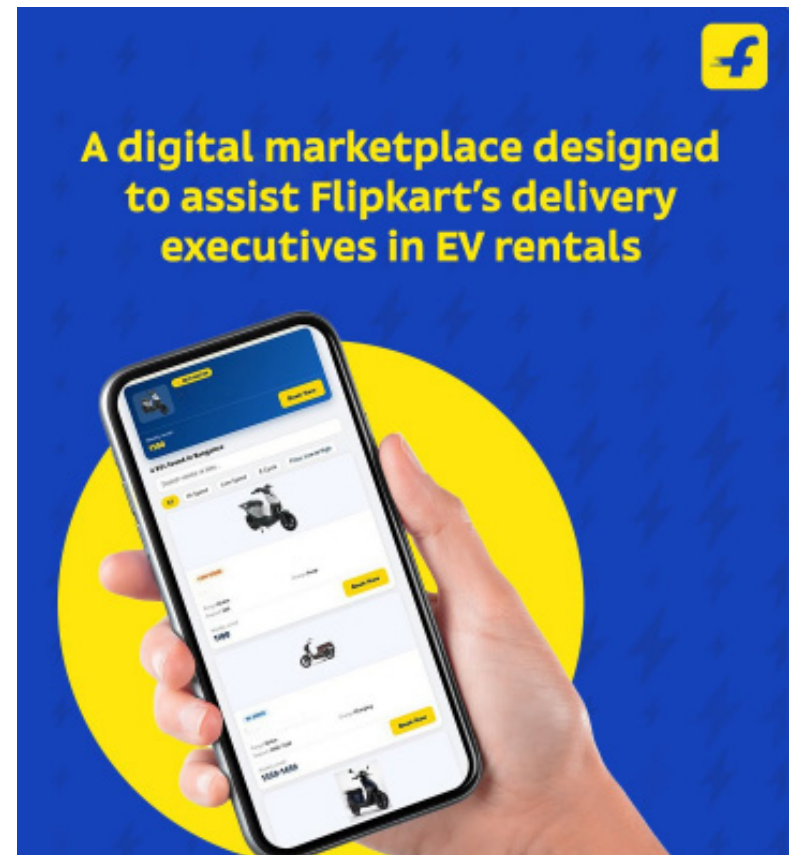
