Justice Demanded for Sattupalli Singareni-Affected Residents BJP Leaders Submit Representation to Union Minister G. Kishan Reddy

“Khammam, July 4 Indian Chronicle: “BJP leaders, led by Khammam District BJP President Nelluri Koteswara Rao, submitted a memorandum to Union Minister

for Coal and Mines, G. Kishan Reddy, seeking immediate intervention to address the severe problems faced by residents affected by Singareni mining operations in the Sattupalli region of Khammam district. “The delegation met the minister at the BJP State Office in Hyderabad on Saturday and highlighted several critical issues arising from the operations of the JVR Open Cast Project (OCP) and the coal silo bunker in the area. “The leaders expressed concern that the silo bunker, located very close to residential areas, has resulted in dense coal dust pollution in localities such as NTR Nagar and Kishtaram. They stated that continuous exposure to coal dust is causing serious health problems among residents, including asthma, tuberculosis, and pneumoconiosis. Despite these growing health concerns, Sattupalli still lacks a multi-specialty hospital, they pointed out. “The delegation also informed the minister that heavy blasting operations in the open-cast mines are causing structural damage to houses in Rajar's, Kishtaram, and the outskirts of Sattupalli, with walls of hundreds of homes developing cracks due to constant vibrations. “Farmers cultivating oil palm, paddy, and mango crops are reportedly suffering significant losses as coal dust and soil particles from overburden (OB) dumps settle on agricultural lands, adversely affecting crop productivity. The leaders further alleged that extensive mining activities have depleted groundwater levels and contributed to contamination from fluoride and heavy metals. “They accused Singareni management of failing to establish adequate green belts to compensate for the large-scale destruction of forest cover, thereby causing environmental degradation in the region. “The BJP leaders also raised concerns regarding inadequate rehabilitation and compensation for displaced families from villages such as Kommapalli and Kishtaram. They alleged that despite bearing the environmental burden of mining operations, local youth are being overlooked for employment opportunities, while contract jobs are being offered to people from outside the area. “Another major issue highlighted was the alleged diversion of District Mineral Foundation (DMF) funds meant for infrastructure development in Sattupalli to other regions, in violation of established guidelines. The leaders further noted that frequent movement of heavy dumpers and trucks has severely damaged the Sattupalli-Kothagudem main road, leading to recurring accidents and loss of lives. “Urging immediate action, the delegation requested the Union Minister to convene a review meeting with the Singareni CMD and senior officials. They called for the adoption of modern technologies to control pollution, speedy justice and rehabilitation for displaced families, and strict directions to ensure that DMF funds are utilized exclusively for the welfare and development of local communities affected by



mining activities. “Those present during the submission of the memorandum included BJP State Treasurer Devaki Vasudeva Rao, State Spokespersons Vakadhani Pulla Rao Yadav and Namburi Ramalingeswara Rao, State Leader Kondapalli Sridhar Reddy, and other party leaders.

Collectors asked to set district-specific targets aligned with State priorities

Chief Secretary Sanjay Jaju calls for focus on agriculture, drinking water, public health and education; says coordinated efforts can deliver visible results within six months.

Karimnagar July 04 (Correspondent): District Collectors have been asked to identify measurable targets in key sectors and align district-level action plans with the State's development priorities to deliver tangible improvements in governance over the next six months.

Reviewing agriculture, drinking water, irrigation, public health, education and weather conditions through a video conference from Hyderabad on Saturday, said smaller districts offered greater administrative efficiency and enabled quicker resolution of local issues. He urged Collectors to closely monitor departmental performance and adopt a goal-oriented approach to governance.

participated in the review meeting from the Karimnagar Collectorate along with senior officials.

Referring to the southwest monsoon, Mr. Jaju said rainfall in the Krishna and Godavari river basins had so far remained below normal. He directed officials to make effective use of the database of nearly 70 lakh beneficiaries under the Rythu Bharosa scheme by sending agricultural advisories, rainfall updates and weather alerts in Telugu through SMS.

The Chief Secretary said sufficient stocks of urea were available in the State and instructed officials to ensure timely distribution while discouraging excessive application. He also called for greater promotion of alternative crops, horticulture and oil palm cultivation. Farmers should be informed about the seven fine paddy varieties eligible for the State bonus, with seeds made available in every mandal. He also advocated expanding vegetable cultivation, particularly in peri-urban areas, to enhance farmers' incomes and improve the supply of fresh produce.

To contain seasonal diseases, Mr. Jaju directed district administrations to step up anti-larval operations and conduct "Dry Day" campaigns every Friday in all gram panchayats and urban local bodies. He emphasised sanitation in residential schools and hostels, daily monitoring of disease trends and adequate availability of medicines. Health officials were instructed to prepare advance lists of pregnant women approaching delivery, ensure regular follow-up and increase institutional deliveries in government hospitals. Describing drinking water as a priority, the Chief Secretary called for uninterrupted supply to urban and rural habitations, prompt repair of pipeline leakages and measures to prevent water wastage. He also directed officials to implement the VBGRAMG scheme effectively, with priority accorded to village-level drinking water works. In the education sector, Mr. Jaju stressed quality monitoring of the midday meal and breakfast schemes and instructed schools to maintain daily records of students, teachers and staff availing the facilities.

Online gambling debt led student to kidnap woman, attempt murder, say police

Karimnagar police arrest 21-year-old degree student accused of abducting a daily wage labourer, robbing her of jewellery and pushing her into a well; victim survives after clinging to a rope overnight..



Karimnagar July 04 (Correspondent): A 21-year-old degree student, allegedly driven by mounting debts after losing money on online gambling platforms, has been arrested for kidnapping a 55-year-old woman, robbing her of her jewellery and attempting to murder her by throwing her into an agricultural well on the outskirts of Karimnagar, police said on Saturday.

Police Commissioner Gaush Alam said the accused, identified as Dhamma Dinesh Reddy of Gollapalli village, was traced and arrested through an investigation involving CCTV footage, mobile phone analysis and other technical evidence.

The victim, Gangadhara Lakshmi, a daily wage labourer, went missing on July 1 while waiting for work at the labour adda near Tower Circle. A missing person case was initially registered at Karimnagar III Town Police Station. As the investigation progressed, police concluded that she had been kidnapped, robbed and subjected to an attempt on her life, prompting the transfer of the case to Karimnagar I Town Police Station.

According to the police, the accused had lost nearly ₹4 lakh through online gambling platforms and colour trading games and had accumulated debts through multiple loan applications. Investigators said he planned the crime to obtain money quickly and carried out reconnaissance in different parts of the city before targeting the victim, who was alone at the labour adda.

Police alleged that he hired a motorcycle taxi and took the woman to agricultural fields near Nustulapur village, where he assaulted her and robbed her of gold ornaments weighing about five grams and 20 grams of silver anklets.

Investigators said the accused then pushed the victim into an agricultural well in an attempt to destroy evidence. When she managed to hold onto a rope inside the well, he allegedly cut it before fleeing. The woman survived by clinging to another rope tied to motor pipes inside the well and remained there throughout the night before being rescued the next morning by farmers who heard her cries for help. She was shifted to the Government General Hospital in Karimnagar for treatment.

During the investigation, police arrested the accused near the Amaraveerula Stupam in the town. They recovered the motorcycle allegedly used in the crime, mobile phones belonging to the accused and the victim, ₹5,000 in cash, and the victim's silver anklets. Police also recovered the stolen gold ornaments from a jewellery trader after the accused allegedly sold them for ₹30,000.

Further investigation is in progress. Police said a chargesheet would be filed after completing the recovery of the remaining property and collecting scientific and other evidence.

Appealing to the public, the police warned against online gambling and illegal betting applications, saying financial distress caused by such platforms could lead to serious crimes. They also advised daily wage labourers to avoid accompanying unknown persons for work without first informing family members or co-workers about the employer's identity, vehicle details and destination.

BJP Erupts Over Alleged Irregularities in Buggapadu Food Park "Preemptive Arrests Cannot Stop Our Fight: BJP Leaders

They reiterated that the party would continue to stand with the people in protecting public assets and farmers' rights. "Dr. Ponguleti Sudhakar Reddy and Nelluri Koteswara Rao also spoke over the phone with detained party leaders, encouraging them and asserting that BJP workers would not be intimidated by arrests. Congress Government Lacks the Capability to Conduct Cooperative Society Elections: Peddi Sudarshan Reddy

“Narsampet, July 4 (Indian Chronicle): BRS senior leader and former Narsampet MLA Peddi Sudarshan Reddy alleged that the Congress government lacks the courage and capability to conduct elections for cooperative societies; instead, it is appointing Congress party leaders to nominated posts. He stated that appointing Congress leaders as 'non-official in-charges' for these societies

is undemocratic and contrary to the spirit of the cooperative movement. “In a media statement released on Saturday, Sudarshan Reddy recalled that during the BRS government's tenure, urea and fertilizers were supplied to farmers on time, grain procurement centers were established, and the menace of spurious seeds was effectively curbed. He noted that, in addition to constructing warehouses for farmers' storage needs, Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs) and seed production centers were set up to strengthen the agricultural sector. “He highlighted that procurement centers were allocated to FPOs, cooperative societies,



and IKP women's groups to ensure their profitable operation. However, he alleged that the current Congress government is allocating these procurement centers exclusively to Congress leaders, enabling them to reap illicit benefits. He pointed out that farmers in all 13 cooperative societies of the Narsampet Assembly constituency had unanimously elected BRS-backed candidates; he argued that the government's decision to appoint individuals to these posts instead of holding elections is proof of its failure. “Furthermore, he accused the Congress government of doing an injustice to farmers by neglecting the implementation of the Rythu Bandhu scheme, misleading them regarding bonuses, delaying crop procurement, failing to make timely payments for procured produce, and not implementing a full agricultural loan waiver. “Sudarshan Reddy criticized the government for failing to effectively utilize available water resources—such as the Pakala and Rangayya Cheruvu projects—despite advance warnings about the impact of 'El Niño'. He noted that during the BRS regime, tanks were filled via pumps until the end of May to provide irrigation water to farmers, whereas the Congress government has allowed the tanks to dry up. “Alleging that the government is undermining the autonomy of farmer-elected cooperative societies, he described the Government Orders (GOs) appointing Congress leaders to administrative positions as undemocratic. Stating that the appointment of nominated 'in-charges' in place of elected governing bodies is unacceptable, Sudarshan Reddy announced that they would approach the courts on behalf of the farmers and hold the Congress government accountable through legal means.

Civil Supplies Department begins advance planning for Kharif procurement.

Karimnagar July 04 (Correspondent): The State Civil Supplies Department has initiated a 100-day advance action plan for the forthcoming Kharif paddy procurement season, with a focus on expediting milling operations and strengthening coordination between officials and rice millers.

Reviewing procurement preparedness at a meeting held at the Karimnagar Collectorate on Saturday, State Civil Supplies Director Shyam Prasad Lal said the department was drawing up an early strategy to ensure the procurement process proceeds without disruption.

He said the State had procured around 82 lakh metric tonnes of paddy during the recent Rabi marketing season through coordinated efforts of the Civil Supplies Department and rice millers. With paddy production during the ensuing Kharif season estimated at about 80 lakh metric tonnes, he called upon officials and millers to prepare well in advance to

handle the expected arrivals efficiently.

Mr. Lal directed rice millers to complete 100% of the milling targets within the government-prescribed deadline. Stressing the need to achieve Custom Milled Rice (CMR) targets on schedule, he said mills should extend working hours, if required, to ensure uninterrupted milling operations.

He also proposed the appointment of a monitoring officer for every rice mill and instructed Civil Supplies officials and Tahsildars to undertake regular field inspections to closely monitor the progress of milling operations.
